“Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen!” (Luke 24:5–6)

Church Council Highlights

March 18, 2026

Dear Church Family,

Our Council met recently on March 18 to review the vibrant work happening within our committees and to prepare for the upcoming Easter season. We are excited to share the following updates on our growth, our property, and our mission to the community.

The Carillon is Ringing! A big thank you to Alan Worley for his technical work in getting our Carillon system operational again. While we are still looking into equipment for a future replacement, it is wonderful to have our bells back in time for Easter!

Fundraising Success: Our recent Candy Sale was a success, raising approximately \$4,700.

- \$500 will be donated to Cocalico Builders of Hope to support the future purchase of a home for this transitional housing program. The remainder directly supports our General Fund.

Our multi-generational "Better Together" Sunday school activity hosted 18 participants (6 kids and 12 adults), and we look forward to our Children's Church singing on Palm Sunday.

The Communications Committee is working hard to keep us connected:

- Thanks to donations we have updated the TVs in front and back of the church. These screens will now display information regarding church life and specific upcoming events.
- Digital Growth: We are officially launching our Instagram presence before Easter! We are also boosting our social media reach for the Community Egg Hunt and coordinating with the Cocalico School District for weekly email flyers.
- Easter Outreach: Postcards and signs are available. Invite folks to worship with us. Join us for a "lit drop" (flyer delivery) at local developments immediately following the Palm Sunday breakfast.

Property Upgrades:

- Air conditioning replacement is scheduled for late April or early May.
- We will also be "picking up sticks" on the Thursday before Easter.

Enhanced Security: For the safety of the congregation the front doors will be locked shortly after the conclusion of the service. Please use the back door to enter the building during Sunday school. You may still use the side door in the sanctuary to exit.

Kitchen Krew Impact: In the last month, the Food Bank provided boxes for 56 families (160 people). Keep an eye out for quarterly R&K sub sales starting after Easter.

Welcome Ministry: We recently mailed 80 greeting cards to members and are excited for our Habitat for Feathered Friends community event on Sunday, May 17 at 10 a.m. This event will include making bird houses, refreshments, and stations including pinecone peanut butter feeders.
