If you've purchased ticket(s) to our performances at **Redondo Union High School** for either Saturday 1/22 @ 7:00 p.m. (*Andy & Renee and Hard Rain*) and/or Saturday 4/9 @ 7:00 p.m. (*Hot October Nights*), THANK YOU! Doors open at 6:30 p.m.

SBCCA is excited to return to in-person shows and enjoy music with you live. **All guests will be able to social distance in the spacious auditorium.**

Tickets purchased by mail with a check were mailed to you along with a version of this letter. If you bought tickets online, please print them from EventBrite.

The health of our performers, volunteers and guests is vital. A face covering must be worn at all times inside the auditorium and seating is every other row at most. **The first few rows will be empty to protect our performers on stage and we ask you not to approach the stage.** There is plenty of room to social distance because the auditorium has more than 1,000 seats. We do not expect a large crowd.

At the entry door, personnel from Redondo Union High School will ask you to take a brief health questionnaire. Their health protocols do not include asking for proof of vaccination or a negative covid test. **With that said, please do not attend the concert if you feel ill, if you tested positive for COVID-19 recently, or you have been exposed recently to anyone you know that has COVID-19 symptoms.**
