Photo Shoot Preparation Checklist

House in general:

- Make sure all of the light bulbs work in the house, including lamp shades.
- All ceiling fans turned off
- Put away anything that is pet related (beds, dishes, toys etc.)
- Put baby gates away
- Open all curtains and drapes, close windows, I'll adjust blinds depending on style
- Remove all clutter from every room, remove family photos, tissue boxes, seasonal decorations
- Clean windows if needed

Kitchen:

- Remove all of the magnets and items off of the refrigerator
- Put away dishes, dish rags, scrubbers, dish racks and related items away
- Counters need to be cleaned off, all that should be visible is small appliances and décor
- Remove toaster ovens
- Remove all trash cans
- Remove mats and rugs off of floor
- Remove free standing paper towel rolls

Bathrooms:

- Clear countertops of all personal items like cups and toothbrushes, remove carpet toilet seat covers
- Put extra toilet paper rolls, toilet brushes, plungers, tissue boxes, air fresheners, and floor mats away
- Clean mirrors with a foam window cleaner, like Sprayway (streaks can really show in our photos)

Bedrooms:

- Make sure the beds are made, put away trash cans, laundry baskets put away
- Make sure there is nothing under the bed that is visible, remove fans and tissue boxes

Outdoors:

- Move vehicles from driveway
- Put garden hoses either in garage, or on the side of the house
- Sweep driveway, back patio etc.
- Garbage bins stored out of sight
- Lawn equipment, children's toys stored out of sight
- Neatly arrange outdoor furniture
- Flags taken down and stored (they move in the wind and cause issues with photos)
- Clean pool and pool area. Take down temporary child fencing and turn on Waterfalls / Spillways
- Pressure wash exterior of home
