



Dog policy

Some Ramblers groups allow walkers to bring their dogs along to walks, but at Sandhurst Health Walks we have a 'no dogs' policy.

There are many reasons for this. There are already many dog walkers who use the Memorial Park, including professional dog walkers who bring groups of dogs. We have had several incidents with dogs off the lead which has led to falls with our walkers. Additionally our most regular walk is grazed by cattle over the summer months. They are easily spooked by dogs and we want to make sure all of our walkers are as safe as we can reasonably make their walking experience with the group.

The only exception to this 'no dogs' policy is guide and other assistance dogs. Providing the dogs are trained and vouched for by organisations such as The Guide Dogs for the Blind Association, or Assistance Dogs UK, they can walk on lead with their owners once they have had a trial walk to ensure the dogs are well behaved and under control by their walker owners.
