What a momentous occasion this is to bring together five separate youth organizations to collaborate on one of the Christmas seasons most anticipated events. With reimagined sets by Broadway designer David Tousley, new costumes by local long time costumer Jeannie Atwell, and featuring the talent of Perdido Performing Arts, Five Star Dance Center, LaBelle Performing Arts, Gulf Coast Elite Gymnastics, and Pensacola Youth Ballet...tonights performance is sure to entertain and delight.

Pensacola Youth Ballet is a 501c3 organization established to provide a premiere training ground for young dancers wishing to pursue a professional career in classical ballet. We have produced four full length ballet performances including Pinnochio, Around The World In 80 Days, Pensacola Youth Ballet's Community Nutcracker, and "An Evening of Dance" which is a gala style performance. We are proud to have raised over \$27,500 in support of The HOPE Foundation, Dixon School of the Arts, The Snoezelen Center, Favor House of North West Florida, Backpack Project USA, and The Secret Place Home. In addition we have provided over \$8,000 in summer study scholarships for our students to attend nationally recognized programs such as American Ballet Theatre, Orlando Ballet, Joffrey Ballet , Nashville Ballet, Cincinnati Ballet, Oklahoma City Ballet, Pittsburg Ballet Theatre, and Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, among others.

Tonight, I am extremely excited to reveal our newest scholarship endeavor "The Legacy Awards". This campaign seeks to bring awareness to Pensacola's own "matriarchs of ballet". These are the individuals who introduced ballet to our community so long ago, and who's contribution advanced the art form in our area. Each organization participating in tonights performance will receive one of these Legacy Scholarships. Each scholarship will be named in honor of one of our ballet matriarchs and will include their story and the impact they had on our local community. Even more exciting, is the opportunity for you to participate in this effort. Guest Artists



Michael Burke

Michael Burke, originally from Mexico, Missouri, trained at the Mareck Center for Dance and Beijing Dance Academy. He graduated from the University of Cincinnati's College Conservatory of Music with a BFA in Ballet. Michael joined Saint Louis Ballet in 2016 under the direction of Gen Horiuchi where he is currently a company member. He has danced with Deos Contemporary Ballet since 2019 for their summer COLLIDE series, festival appearances, and dance for film projects. Michael has also performed with Indianapolis Ballet, Terpsicorps Theatre of Dance, Kentucky Ballet Theatre, and Birmingham Ballet. Highlights from his performance career include Albrecht in Giselle, Prince Siegfried in Swan Lake, the principal pas de deux in Christopher Wheeldon's Within the Golden Hour and The American, the leading roles in George Balanchine's Allegro Brillante, Square Dance, and Valse Fantasie, Twyla Tharp's Nine Sinatra Songs, John Keats in Tess Sinke's My Dearest Girl, and The Mad Hatter in Brian Enos's Alice in Wonderland. He has also originated roles in works by Amy Seiwert, Steve Rooks, Kevin Jenkins, Emery LeCrone, and Princess Grace Award winner Kameron N. Saunders. As an instructor, Michael has taught ballet, men's technique, pas de deux, pointe, variations, contemporary, and conditioning to students of all ages, including for the Professional Training Program at Saint Louis Ballet. He has had students place in the top 12 at the Youth America Grand Prix. Michael is an ABT® Certified Teacher and is also a certified in Progressing Ballet Technique.



Rick Vigo

Rick Vigo began his ballet training with Linda Stark, Starr Burlingame, and Dorothy Lister in Pensacola. He has also studied at Emory University, FSU, The Alvin Ailey American Dance Center in NYC, and the Dance Complex in Boston. He has performed with HT Chen and Dancers, Anna Myer and Dancers, Tony Williams Dance Company, Jose Mateo Ballet Theatre, The Tallahassee Ballet, Walt Disney World, Celebrity Cruises, Bally's "Jubilee!" in Las Vegas, and many others. He has taught and choreographed for various studios in the Boston area as well as, more recently, The Tallahassee Ballet and Sharon Davis School of Dance. His work has been shown at The Dance Complex, Wellesley College, The Strand Theatre, and FSU. In 2022, after returning to FSU as a student, Rick received his BFA in Dance. Rick is currently pursuing a Masters degree in Exercise Science at the University of West Florida and hopes to begin a doctoral program in physical therapy next year. This is his first time performing with Pensacola Youth Ballet.
