The Firearms Act 2015 provides a general amnesty to enable persons to surrender any unauthorised or unwanted firearm, part or ammunition to a police station or a participating licensed dealer. Individuals possessing unregistered firearms, parts, or ammunition can surrender them legally without fine or penalty - even if you do not hold a valid firearms licence.

Important Safe Transport Steps (Per SAPOL Guidelines)

Before traveling to our premises during daylight hours, please follow these simple steps:

- 2 **Keep it fully concealed** in a gun bag, hard case, or wrapped securely in a blanket/towel to avoid public alarm.
- 3 **Keep ammunition separate** from the firearm in a distinct bag or container.
