RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SCHOOL NURSE

- Provide health services to scholars and promote health, while upholding family rights and all applicable laws.
- Provide nursing care to ill or injured scholars.
- Carry out all required information collection, record keeping, and reporting, while maintaining confidentiality.
- Administer medications as prescribed.
- To scholars and staff provide First Aid and CPR and monitor vital signs as needed.
- Collaborate in maintaining safety and security.
- Provide health education as assigned.
- Assist the Guidance Counselor to promote a positive learning environment for all scholars, while managing scholar conduct effectively.
- Contribute to scholar-related operations, for example, monitoring recess.
- Participate in professional development.
- Perform other duties before, during, or after school, as assigned by the Principal.
