DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

1. CAIRNS - NARITA - TOKYO

Meet your tour director at Cairns International Airport to board your Jetstar flight bound for Tokyo's Narita Airport. Upon arrival transfer by chartered coach to your inner-city hotel located in the Daiba area of Tokyo. (Flight departs Cairns at 12.25pm and arrives Narita 6.25pm)

2. TOKYO

See Tokyo at its dynamic best with an action-packed day of sightseeing taking in the Imperial Palace, Asakusa Temple and Nakamise shopping arcade as well as the impressive 634m high Tokyo Sky Tree. In the afternoon travel north by coach to Ashikaga Flower Park – home to Japan's famous wisteria tunnels. Weather permitting, you'll have the opportunity to view the spectacular night-time illumination. Return to your Tokyo accommodation in the evening. **BLD**

3.TOKYO - HANAMAKI - HIRAIZUMI

Transfer by coach to Tokyo station to depart for Ichinoseki by super express bullet train before commencing your half-day sightseeing in Hiraizumi – the former pollical and cultural capital of Northern Japan. Enjoy a scenic stop at Genbikei Gorge - a beautiful 2km stretch of gorge along the Iwai River. Visitors can enjoy the dynamic views of the waterfalls and unique rock formations created by the river's erosion as they stroll along the riverside. Tonight's hotel is ideally located in the heart of one of Northern Japan's most popular hot spring areas where you'll get the opportunity to enjoy the benefits of hot spring bathing. **B L D**

4. HIRAIZUMI - ICE CORRIDOR - LAKE TOWADA

Continue today through Japan's beautiful countryside by chartered coach for a full-day sightseeing including stops at Koiwai Farm and the Hachimantai Aspite Ice Corridor. Koiwai Farm spans over 3000 hectares, of which two thirds are covered with a cedar forest while the remaining third is the actual farmland, including pastures and farm buildings. Continue towards Lake Towada via the Hachimantai Aspite Line - a 27km driving route traversing Mount Hachimantai .The driving route is lined by snow walls, known as the Snow Corridor, formed by snow ploughs cutting through the deep snow drifts. Tonight's accommodation in located on stunning Lake Towada - the largest caldera lake on Honshu Island.

5 LAKE TOWADA – AOMORI

Enjoy a morning cruise of Lake Towada before travelling further north towards Aomori City, the northernmost prefectural capital city on Honshu, Japan's main island. Sit back and enjoy the passing scenery through the Japanese countryside as we make our way via Oirase Gorge, one of the most beautiful river valleys in Japan. The Oirase stream flows from the crystal-clear waters of Lake Towada, creating a number of rapids and waterfalls that add to the gorge's beauty. **B L D**

6 AOMORI – HIROSAKI – AOMORI

Leave Aomori by chartered coach for full-day sightseeing in the culturally rich city of Hirosaki. Hirosaki Park is home to 2600 cherry trees with over 50 different types of cherry including Somei Yoshino cherry blossoms, weeping cherry and double layer cherry and is famed as one of Japan's "top 10" cherry blossom viewing sites. After lunch visit the Neputa Festival hall for a hands-on cultural experience. **B L**





7 AOMORI – HAKODATE (HOKKAIDO)

Today travel by JR super express bullet train to the city of Hakodate via the Seikan Tunnel – the world's longest undersea tunnel (54 klms in length)

Full-day sightseeing by coach taking in the main sights of the city including the Hakodate Botanical Gardens where you can see Japan's famed snow monkeys. This evening take in the breathtaking night views of the city as you ascend by cable car to the top of Mount Hakodate. **B** L





8 HAKODATE

Start the day wandering Hakodate's bustling *asaichi* (morning market), where hundreds of stores and stalls sell fresh local produce, seafood and the odd souvenir. Ascend Goryokaku Tower for views over Goryokaku Fort and Mount Hakodate before visiting the Museum of Northern Peoples which holds and exhibits everyday items of Northern peoples, including many Ainu folkcrafts. **B** L





9 HAKODATE - SHIRAOI - SAPPORO

Full-day sightseeing towards Sapporo by chartered coach stopping at Shikabe Geyser Park, Lake Toya and the Shiraoi Upopoy Ainu village - Japan's northernmost national museum, dedicated to the preservation of Japan's indigenous Ainu culture. In addition to the lake itself, the Toyako region features hot springs and an active volcano, Mount Usu, which last erupted in the year 2000.

Arrive Sapporo early evening - the capital of Hokkaido and Japan's fifth largest city B L
