# EXHIBIT HALL ENTRIES

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. NO PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. BRING ITEMS AND COMPLETED ENTRY FORM TO THE EXHIBIT HALL AT THE ORANGE COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS ON DAYS AND TIMES LISTED BELOW:

\*\*On Monday night, June 22, 2026, from 5-7p.m., entries will be received in the Exhibit Hall. (Entries in the Food Preparation, Garden Produce, and Flowers and Plants Departments will NOT be accepted this night.)

\*\*On Tuesday night, June 23, 2026, from 5-7p.m., entries will be accepted in ALL departments.

\*\*On Wednesday morning, June 24, 2026 from 7-9a.m., ONLY entries in the Food Preparation, Garden Produce, and Flowers and Plants Departments will be accepted.

2. Youth (ages 19 and under) who enter 12 or more entries in the Exhibit Hall, will receive one (1) free day pass per person to get into the Fair. Please inquire when you are checking in your 12 items.

3. Entries are open to residents of the State of Virginia.

4. Only one entry per exhibitor per class.

5. The Exhibit Hall will be CLOSED during judging of entries on Wednesday, June 24, 2026, from 9:00a.m. to 3:00p.m.

6. Entries cannot be removed from exhibit area before 8-9p.m. Saturday, June 27, and Sunday, June 28, 9a.m.-12 noon. Everyone who attends the Fair has a right to view them.

7. Articles exhibited must be the work of the person whose name they are entered and must have been completed since the last Fair.

8. Classes with only one entry will be awarded placing at the judge's discretion.

9. Read each department's general rules.

10. The Orange County Fair Association, Inc. reserves the right to refuse any entry offered and require removal from the grounds of an exhibit or animal which the Board of Directors shall for any reason deem unfit or objectionable.

11. The exhibitor assumes all risks of damage or loss either to person or property for any cause whatsoever. It is

further expressly understood and agreed between the Exhibitor and the Orange County Fair Association, Inc.

12. All complaints must be presented in writing to the Orange County Fair Association, Inc. no later than 30 days after the close of the Fair.

13. The use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, abusive language or other abusive misconduct is prohibited.

14. The Executive Committee reserves the right to close or prohibit any feature of the Fair that, in their opinion, is objectionable

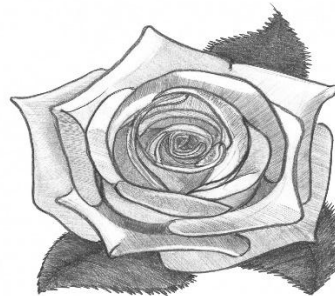
