Spring - officially begins on March 21st, but for many of us, it feels like spring encompasses March, April, and May. Even if the ground is still blanketed in snow as you read this, some of you might catch glimpses of crocuses peeking through.

Spring is my favorite season of the year. After the dormancy and perceived death of winter, vibrant colors burst forth in many places. Crocuses are usually the first to emerge, followed closely by lilies of the valley, hyacinths, daffodils, and tulips. If your spring flowers are planted close to your home, in a sheltered spot, or in a sundrenched area, they'll bloom even earlier.

I have a special fondness for lilies of the valley, as they were one of my father's favorite flowers and often bloomed in time for his early March birthday. A Christian hymn written in 1881 for the Salvation Army even refers to Jesus as the Lily of the Valley.

Read the love poem in Song of Solomon, chapter 2, to find mention of the lily of the valleys.

**Transformation**—Spring is such a beautiful reminder of renewal, as we witness signs of new life all around us. It's a season of transformation and growth. Similarly, in Christ, we too can experience this kind of transformation. 2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV) speaks to this truth: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Have you experienced this kind of change in your life through Christ? Are there any old habits, thoughts, or patterns that need to pass away, making space for something new? Let us make it our constant prayer to be continually renewed by Christ, day by day, as we grow in His grace and embrace the new life He offers.

Bible study will start at 7 pm meet with doors opening at 6:30 pm.


