A Leader:

A leader can be someone officially designated as the chief, head, or boss. However, many lead without an official title by coaching, guiding, and inspiring others.

A Christian Leader: A Christian leader guides and serves others in a manner consistent with Christian values and principles, living by faith in Jesus Christ.

A Crossfire Leader: A Crossfire leader is someone identified as a leader responsible for planning, organizing, and leading Crossfire events. They rely on volunteers and the Crossfire Team for successful events.

Crossfire Team: The Crossfire Team consists of volunteers who lead by example. They help make events happen by performing tasks from setup to teardown and cleanup. Volunteers may wear a "Crossfire Team" sticker to indicate they are part of the team and can answer questions or direct you to a leader.
