

Top Gun Springers Health Guarantee

HEALTH GUARANTEE/ PUPPY SALES CONTRACT

This Health Guarantee Contract outlines the terms and conditions of the sale of a puppy from the breeder to the buyer.

Since 1992.

Examination Period: The buyer has five (5) working days from the date of delivery of the puppy to have the puppy examined by a licensed veterinarian. If the veterinarian discovers any life-threatening genetic defects or illnesses during this examination period, the buyer may exchange the puppy for one of equal value or receive a full refund upon returning the puppy and providing a veterinarian statement. The buyer will be responsible for any fees associated with the return of the puppy, as well as any fees associated with the exchange of the puppy.

Guarantee Period: After the expiration of the examination period, the puppy is guaranteed for one (1) year against any life-threatening genetic defects. If such a defect is discovered during this guarantee period and is supported by a veterinarian statement, the buyer may receive a replacement puppy of equal value, subject to availability. The replacement option is only valid if the health problem is due to a hereditary problem and not due to an accident or contagious and/or other illness.

Exclusions: The following slight genetic defects are not considered serious or life-threatening and are therefore not covered by this guarantee: umbilical hernia, cherry eye, allergies, un-descended testicle, underbite, or overbite. The breeder cannot guarantee the disposition, temperament, conformation, size, weight, color, or breeding abilities of the puppy.

Health Risks: The breeder cannot control the exposure the puppy encounters after leaving their premises. The buyer acknowledges that puppies may experience stress when moving to their new home, which can lead to the development of dormant conditions such as parasites, ear mites, colds, hypoglycemia, coccidia, and giardia. The buyer acknowledges that these conditions are treatable and do not warrant reimbursement.

Maintaining Records: This guarantee will be null and void if documented and/or verified veterinarian visits and records are not maintained. The guarantee is non-transferable and only applies to the original buyer named in this contract.

Hip Dysplasia Guarantee: In the unlikely event that a puppy is suspected of being dysplastic in its first two (2) years, the breeder will guarantee a replacement puppy if the following procedure is followed:

- 1. The buyer must notify the breeder by telephone or letter within ten (10) business days of the diagnosis.
- The Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) must find the dog to be "Severely Dysplastic".
- 3. The buyer must provide a veterinarian statement detailing that the dog has had x-rays, is not overweight for its height and structure, and has obtained regular check-ups.

- 4. The x-ray must have been taken within the first year of age.
- 5. The dog must have never been bred.
- 6. The dog must be in the care of the original buyer.
- 7. The breeder has the right to have a second opinion from their own vet of choice at the buyer's expense.
- 8. All shipping costs for the returned animal and replacement are the responsibility of the purchaser.

Vaccinations and General Health Information: The puppy has had its first vaccination shots against parvovirus, parainfluenza, adenovirus, distemper, and coronavirus, as indicated on the Puppy Data Sheet. The breeder also maintains a deworming schedule for their puppies. The buyer should continue to monitor the puppy's health and follow the provided care and training instructions.

Holding Agreement: The buyer must provide a \$200.00 deposit to hold the puppy. This deposit is non-refundable and will be applied to the purchase price of the puppy when the buyer assumes physical possession of the assigned dog.
