The Wonderful Life

Our creator, Yahuah Elohim (the LORD G_d), is amazing. He is the most wonderful being in existence: loving selflessly, set-apart to all that is righteous, good and just, impartial, does only what is the best for eternal existence. He is all powerful, all wise, all knowing, everywhere present in time and space.

Because of his wisdom, love and goodness he created this physical universe and angels and mankind, the angels to serve mankind, and we humans to be closer to him in relationship than they.

We only know this physical universe and nothing about the spirit non-material one where angels, Satan and demons live. We know, however, they can affect the physical and influence our lives, and only do what Yahuah tells them to do or allows them to do.

Satan cannot force us to do anything against our will. All he can do is appeal to our selfishness. Because Khawwah wanted the fruit, she was deceived into believing the fruit was okay to eat. So it is with every disobedience to Elohim we want to do. Adam was not deceived, but ate it anyway because of his love for Khawwah, knowing she couldn't survive outside the garden without his help.

The moment they ate it their perfect relationship with Yahuah ended. They now had to depend on their own understanding. So it is with all their descendants, including us. We have all sinned and fallen

short of the perfection of our creator (Rom. 3:23), therefore we all deserve to be separated eternally from our creator, called hell.

The good news is Yahuah has made a way for our sins to be forgiven and be restored to that first relationship in the Garden. Angels are spirit beings who directly saw the beauty and perfection of Yahuah. Their one test was learning that we humans would be higher than they and would rule over them.
