Home Inspection

Appraisal

Appraisal time! With your lender, we'll get an appraisal to know your home's value.

11

Closing Day

You made it! We'll do a final walkthrough, making sure everything is "broom clean," and voila – the keys are yours. Congratulations! 🏡
