ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Pittsburgh ~ Strip District ~ Heinz Chapel ~ Point State Park:

Depart by motor coach for Pittsburgh. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically as we travel. The nation's largest inland port, Pittsburgh, famous for its Three Rivers, lies at the point where the Allegheny and Monongahela rivers meet to form the Ohio River. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at the historic Strip District. Later this afternoon embark on a guided sightseeing tour of Pittsburgh including stops at University of Pittsburgh's gothic towering Heinz Chapel and Point State Park, original site of Fort Duquesne. Gather for dinner at a local restaurant and then transfer to nearby Uniontown for the overnight.

Day 2: Amtrak's *Floridian* ~ Allegheny Mountains ~ Washington, DC ~ Smithsonian

Museums: This morning we board Amtrak's *Floridian* for a delightful train ride to Washington, DC. This all-American rail excursion follows the original B&O line through the Allegheny Mountains, along the scenic Youghiogheny River, across western Maryland and into the beautiful Potomac Valley. Enjoy spectacular views that can only be seen by train. Travel through Harpers Ferry, located at the confluence of the Shenandoah and Potomac rivers. Upon arrival in our nation's capital, enjoy free time exploring the wonderful Smithsonian museums. Choose from several options including the National Museum of American History, National Air & Space Museum or National Museum of Natural History. Following a dinner stop we arrive at our hotel for a delightful two-night stay.

Day 3: Arlington National Cemetery ~ Monuments & Memorials ~ Illumination Tour:

Following breakfast at the hotel travel to Arlington National Cemetery. Embark on a guided tram tour which stops at the Kennedy gravesites and the Tomb of the Unknowns for the Changing of the Guard ceremony. After a lunch break, we embark on a relaxing and scenic guided tour of Washington DC's monuments and memorials. Each spring DC showcases 3,000 cherry trees with their vibrant pale pink and white flowers. During our tour stops will be made at the World War II War Memorial, Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, and Vietnam War Memorial. Additional sights will also include the U.S. Capitol, White House, Washington Monument, Jefferson Memorial and the Tidal Basin area. Later today we gather for dinner at a local restaurant followed by an evening illumination drive throughout the Washington, D.C. area.

Day 4: Washington DC ~ Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception

~ Journey Home: Enjoy breakfast at the hotel and then visit the beautiful Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception. The National Shrine, which is the largest church in the America's and the eighth largest in the world, features outstanding mosaics and stained-glass windows. Later today we leave DC and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
