

IT'S A GREAT TIME TO BE A SENIOR.

The Madison County Senior Citizen's Center has a wide range of services and activities which are aimed at keeping seniors living independently for as long as possible, as well as providing socialization opportunities.

Transportation can assist seniors who are no longer able to drive to doctor appointments, pharmacy, grocery store, outpatient services and other needed trips. *Doctor appointments take top priority.

Handicapped accessible vans are available with trained drivers for those who are disabled.

You must be 60 years or over and live in Madison County to be eligible for the transportation services.

TRANSPORTATION

The Madison County Senior Citizens Center Transportation service was designed to enable a consumer's plan of care when medical transportation is not otherwise available or funded by state plan Medicaid or any other source.

Whenever possible, consumers should use family, neighbors, friends or community agencies to provide this service without charge.

TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

Local and Out of Town Trips:

- All transportation is on a first come, first served basis.
- One working day notice is required on any transportation.
- No transportation will be scheduled more than two weeks in advance.

EMERGENCY TRIPS

All emergency trips will be made to doctors and hospitals the same day if vans and drivers are available.

Transportation Services is designed to move clients to and from services, activities and resources at an affordable cost to the individual.

A sliding scale using the federal poverty guidelines based on the individual's income is used to determine cost of the transportation service to the individual. No senior is denied service based on ability to pay.
