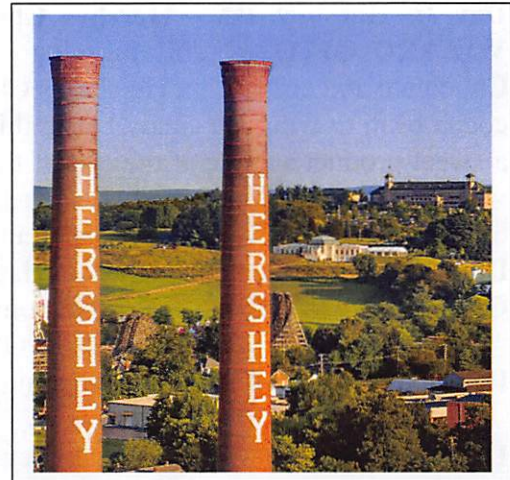

ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Flight 93 Memorial ~ Lancaster County, PA: Depart aboard a deluxe highway coach for Lancaster, PA. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later today we arrive in Shanksville and visit Flight 93 Memorial which honors the 40 brave souls that gave their lives on September 11, 2001. Following a lunch break journey east to Lancaster County for a delightful three-night stay.

Day 2: Historic Strasburg Railroad ~ Kitchen Kettle Village ~ Sight & Sound's NOAH: This morning, we ride the historic Strasburg Railroad, America's oldest operating railroad with a charter dating back to June 9, 1832. Embark on a scenic round-trip ride through the tranquil Amish countryside to the quaint town of Paradise. Later today enjoy free time for lunch and shopping at Kitchen Kettle Village, a unique complex of shops and eateries. This afternoon we arrive at the Sight and Sound Theater for the spectacular production, NOAH. With a catastrophic storm on its way, Noah is given a monumental task: build a boat big enough to save his family from a flood that will cover the entire earth. As Noah endeavors to live faithfully amid an increasingly chaotic world, can he trust that God's promises run deeper than the rising waters around him? Set sail inside the enormous ark as this extraordinary story comes to life in this special 30th anniversary season! Following the show we gather for a delicious Amish-style dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 3: Hershey, PA ~ Hershey Chocolate World Tour ~ Dutch Apple Dinner Theater's WIZARD OF OZ: This morning we travel to Hershey, PA. Arrive at Hershey World of Chocolate and embark on Hershey's Chocolate Tour. Take an educational journey from tropical cocoa bean to wrapped candy bar in this chocolate factory tour ride. Delight your tastebuds with a sweet product sample at the end of the tour followed by free time for shopping. This evening, we attend the Dutch Apple Dinner Theater for a delicious dinner followed by the musical Wizard of Oz.
