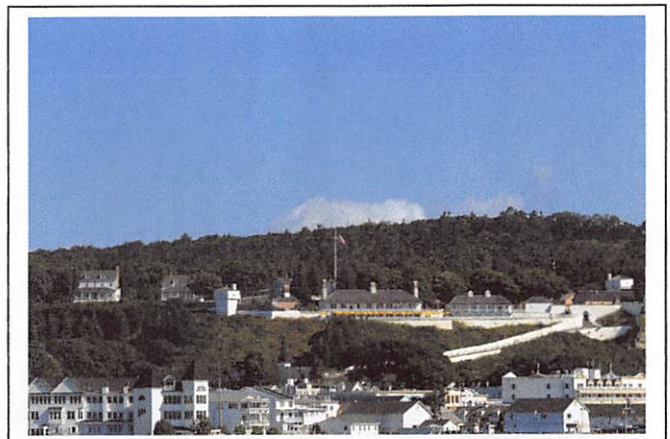

## ITINERARY

- Day 1: Home City ~ Frankenmuth ~ Bronner's Christmas Wonderland:** Travel by deluxe highway coach to Frankenmuth, Michigan. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Upon arrival in Frankenmuth a stop will be made at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland. Recognized as the world's largest Christmas store, Bronner's features more than 50,000 ornaments, lights and decorations including Nativity scenes ranging from tiny hand-carved figures to life-size scenes, animated figures, collectibles, outdoor décor and decorated Christmas trees. Arrive at the Bavarian Inn Lodge for dinner and overnight.
- Day 2: Frankenmuth Sights ~ The National Shrine of the Cross in the Woods ~ Mackinac Island:** After breakfast we embark on guided tour of Frankenmuth. Drive through Little Bavaria and view Glockenspiel Tower and a replica of the 19<sup>th</sup>-century Holz-Bruccke – Frankenmuth's wooden covered bridge that spans the Cass River. Later this morning we depart for Mackinac Island. En route a stop will be made at The National Shrine of the Cross in the Woods in Indian River. The massive bronze sculpture of the crucified Christ was titled "The Man on the Cross" by the renowned Michigan sculptor Marshall Fredericks. It weighs seven tons, is twenty-eight feet tall from head to toe, and the outstretched arms span twenty-one feet. Later this afternoon we arrive in St. Ignace where we board a ferry and sail across the Straits of Mackinac to charming Mackinac Island. Enjoy a delightful two-night stay at the Lake View Hotel, located along the main street in town.
- Day 3: Mackinac Island Carriage Tour ~ Grand Hotel ~ Mackinac Island at leisure:** Today we explore beautiful Mackinac Island. The island is only three miles long and two miles wide with a rugged shoreline. Besides a fire truck, ambulance and public utility truck, no motor vehicles are permitted on the island. Embark on a scenic horse-drawn carriage ride around the island. Historical highlights include Fort Mackinac, Arch Rock, Skull Cave, Governor's Mansion and Surry Hill. End our tour at the beautiful Grand Hotel where we are treated to the fabulous luncheon buffet. Glimmering like a diamond on an island of brilliant green, Grand Hotel beckons you to a bygone era of old-world hospitality and charm. Later today we return to our hotel and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure. Stroll through town and enjoy the many shops, boutiques and restaurants.
- Day 4: Mackinac Island ~ Journey Home:** Following breakfast at the hotel we re-board the ferry and return to the mainland. Upon arrival back in St. Ignace, we board our coach and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made en route.

# TRAVEL

## ACTIVITY LEVELS



### LEVEL 1

#### LIGHT & LEISURELY

**You're a leisurely traveler.** You like to take it easy and people-watch. You can climb at least one flight of stairs, board a coach, and walk unassisted at a relaxed pace for up to 60 minutes without difficulty. You can handle altitudes up to 5,000 feet. \*\*

### LEVEL 2

#### MODERATE

**You like a balanced approach to travel.** Walking two or three miles over the course of the day is no problem. You can take part in a two-hour leisurely walking tour (with breaks). You can handle a variety of terrains, from cobblestone streets to moderate hills. You can climb flights of stairs with ease and stand in line for short periods. You can handle altitudes of 6000 feet. \*\*

### LEVEL 3

#### ACTIVE

**You're an on-the-go traveler.** You don't want to miss a thing, so walking and standing for long periods are no problem. A moderately paced two or three-hour walking tour, covering miles, with hills and uneven surfaces, is no problem. You can easily handle altitudes between 6000 and 9000 feet. \*\*

### LEVEL 4

#### VERY ACTIVE

**You're ready to seize the day, whatever it may bring.** You lead an active life at home; 10,000 steps a day is normal. You can handle longer walks, more than 3 hours, covering more than 3 miles at a steady clip, with activities that involve uneven terrain, steep slopes, and standing for long periods of time, at varying altitudes and temperatures. This level is not appropriate for travelers using wheelchairs, walkers, and other mobility assistance.

**\*\* Trip may fall between two activity levels.**
