1 Timothy 6:12 – Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and for which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

Matthew 10:32 – Therefore, everyone who confesses Me before people, I will also confess him before My Father who is in heaven.

Luke 8:39 – “Return to your home and describe what great things God has done for you.” So, he went away, proclaiming throughout the city what great things Jesus had done for him.

And the more notable **John 3:16** – For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life.

A life dedicated to Christ is a powerful testimony, especially when our actions of godly living match the words coming from our lips. So be a living testimony and show others the truth in finding salvation.
