The Bible provides us many reference versus in scripture relating to King of Kings, Lord of Lords:

Psalms 95:3 – “For the Lord is the great God, the great King above all gods.” This verse affirms God's sovereignty above all other rulers.

Daniel 2:47 – The king said to Daniel, “Surely your God is the God of gods and the Lord of kings and a revealer of secrets.” This shows recognition of God's ultimate authority over earthly kings.

Deuteronomy 10:17 – For the Lord your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God, who is not partial and takes no bribe.

Psalms 136:2-3 – Give thanks to the God of gods, For His faithfulness is everlasting. Give thanks to the Lord of lords, for his steadfast love endures forever;
