As a Contractor or homeowner that previously submitted a USA dig ticket in the Reno/Sparks area, this letter is to inform you that NV Energy operates and maintains a natural gas distribution system of services, mains, and transmission pipelines that deliver efficient, clean - burning and safe energy to our customers. As part of our comprehensive safety program, we work closely with the communities we serve to educate them about pipeline safety. **With excavation damage being the #1 cause of gas related incidents**, we use several methods to communicate our message specifically to Contractors including the targeted distribution of the following materials: "Call Before You Dig" program, Natural Gas Safety Awareness training, Public Service Announcements, and pipeline markers.

NV Energy believes that your company is highly committed to providing a safe work environment for your employees. To further your efforts, we have provided the link to The Natural Gas/Propane Safety Handout in English and Spanish for you to review. This handout provides the following information:

If a gas leak is suspected, or to report unauthorized excavations or suspicious activities at an NV Energy Gas facility or pipeline right-of-way, please call our 24-hour emergency number at 775-834-4100.

Remember, it is part of Nevada's law (NRS455/NAC455) to Call Before You Dig. Make sure you call 811 or go online at <http://www.usanorth811.org> at least two (2) days before you dig. 811 is a free service that will ensure the utility lines in your excavation area are marked.
