Thank you for booking a lobster boat tour with us. Listed below are a list of items we recommend bringing with you on the tour, answers to some frequently asked questions, as well as the directions to our location.

Please feel free to ask any further questions before the tour by email, voicemail, or text us.

Please arrive 15 minutes before your scheduled tour time, we are on a set schedule and leave exactly at the scheduled tour time. **Anyone late will be left behind!!**

We try and run every scheduled tour and hope for the best of weather ☀ but every day is not perfect on the ocean, sometimes we will have some light wind, a light chop, light rain/mist, & fog and this can happen suddenly. So please be prepared for cooler temperatures, sea spray onto the boat, and possible misty wet weather. We do cancel and try and reschedule if we have high winds, pouring rain, dense fog, rough seas, and sometimes other unforeseen circumstances. If we must cancel, we will reach out at least an hour before your scheduled tour, and we will work with you to see if we can reschedule for a different day, or we will give a 100% refund. If you are no show or cancelling less than 24 hours without a very good reason, we will not be given a refund. We might also give the option if the weather is not ideal conditions to go all the way out to Petit Manan to change the tour and do just a one-hour seals & lobster trap hauling tour.

NOTE: If you need more than 1 hours' notice if we must cancel, please let us know!

Every paying customer gets a lobster meal prepared at the dock for your lunch/dinner. If you are feeling adventurous you can also take it to cook yourself and we can give you cooking instructions or we can steam them up to go. Our lobster meal consists of one lobster, warm drawn butter, corn on the cob, and a dinner roll. There will be our onsite food trailer available to buy sides, chowders, desserts, and beverages. There will also be other food options for anyone not wanting to eat lobster. If anyone is interested, we do sell additional lobsters for a flat rate.

We can't always guarantee wildlife, but we do our best to try and locate them. Puffins usually start arriving in May and do start to migrate from the island around the end of July, so we would like to make people aware that after August 1st you will most likely not see puffins. If we don't catch enough legal-size lobsters from the traps that we haul on the tour, we do keep lobsters at our dock to make sure that every paying customer gets one.

Guests can opt out of the lobster meal, but we cannot substitute for a different meal. We can credit the lobster back, and if you choose you can purchase something else at the onsite food trailer. If you choose this option, please let us know before the start of the tour.

ITEMS TO BRING:

- We provide Coast Guard approved life jackets for all passengers, however if your child has their own Coast Guard approved life jacket that you would like to bring feel free to do so. All children 10 & under are required by law to wear a life jacket while on board the vessel.
- Snacks & Drinks (Alcoholic beverages are permitted)
- Light jacket, Sweater or Sweatshirt – **THE AIR TEMPERATURE ON LAND CAN BE VERY WARM BUT, ON THE WATER, IT CAN BE VERY CHILLY, SO PLEASE COME PREPARED.**
- Sometimes if we have some wind it will kick up occasional sea spray onto the boat, so if you don't want to take a chance of getting wet it may be good to bring a rain jacket or poncho. We do have ponchos & blankets on board if needed.
- Footwear that has good tread
- Sunglasses/Sunscreen, Hat, Camera, Binoculars
- If you experience motion sickness, try, and take something that helps with it before your tour like a non-drowsy medication, wear a motion sickness band or patch. If you take motion sickness medication, try taking it the night before as well as the morning of your tour not when you arrive. We do have some motion sickness patches & medicine available for purchase in the check-in building.

DIRECTIONS:

From Rt 186 you turn on Rt 195 Corea Road, you stay on that road for a little over 3 miles. When you come into Corea you will go past Crowley Island Road, and the Corea post office which will be on your left, make sure the harbor is on your left. Not far past you will come to a sharp turn in the road, and after that turn you will veer off onto Francis Pound Road. You will start on the tar and then it goes to dirt make sure to stay to the right, you will see signs for our tour and for the Bell Buoy Seafood & Takeout, continue until you come to the parking lot, after you have parked come into the Check In building and we will get you signed in. If you have any problems, please call or text us and we will come to find you or guide you to us. Google Maps does good with our location but can sometimes be confusing once you get into Corea.

We are also pet friendly, so if you have a well-behaved dog, they are not afraid of the boat, are on a leash or being held, and friendly around adults/children they are welcome to join.

Only one pet per reservation unless authorized by the owner/captain.
