ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN

Please arrive 15 minutes prior to your scheduled departure time.

Our tours run on a strict schedule and leave promptly. Late arrivals may be left behind.

Park in the designated area and check in at the Check-In Building.



WEATHER & TOUR CONDITIONS

The ocean can change quickly! Be prepared for wind, chop, sea spray, fog, and cooler temperatures.

For safety, tours may be canceled or modified due to high winds, rough seas, heavy rain, dense fog, or other circumstances.

If we cancel, you'll receive a full refund or the option to reschedule.

WILDLIFE & SCENERY



We do our best to find wildlife, including seals, puffins (May-July), eagles, and seabirds.

Whales are rare in our area but occasionally seen (minke, humpback, or pilot whales).

After August 1st, puffin sightings are unlikely as they begin to migrate.



PET FRIENDLY

Well-behaved dogs are welcome aboard!

- Must be leashed or held
- Friendly with people and other dogs
- Limit: 1 pet per reservation (unless approved by the captain)



PETIT MANAN ISLAND

Protected nesting ground for Atlantic puffins and seabirds.

Closed to the public April 1 – August 31.

You may see wildlife biologists and interns working on the island.



WHAT TO BRING

- ✓ Light jacket or sweater
- ✓ Rain jacket or poncho
- ✓ Footwear with good tread
- ✓ Sunglasses, sunscreen, hat, camera, binoculars
- ✓ Snacks & drinks (alcoholic beverages permitted)
- ✓ Motion sickness prevention (take before arrival)



CHILD SAFETY

We provide Coast Guard-approved life jackets for all passengers.

Children 10 & under are required by law to wear a life jacket while onboard.



DIRECTIONS

From Rt 186, turn onto Rt 195 (Corea Road) and go 3 miles into Corea. Pass Crowley Island Road and the Corea Post Office (on your left). Keep the harbor on your left. After the sharp turn, veer onto Francis Pound Road. Stay right as the road turns to dirt. Follow signs for Lobster Boat Tours and The Bell Buoy Seafood & Takeout. Continue to the parking area and proceed to the Check-In Building.
