# TEEN DRIVER SAFETYACT

RESTRICTIONS (INSTRUCTION PERMIT, UNDER 18)

- Have a licensed driver who is at least 21 years seated in the front seat next to you.
- Have your Graduated Instruction Permit with you while driving.
- Hold your Graduated Instruction Permit for at least six months, if under 18, and complete 30 hours of supervised driving practice, including at least 10 hours of night time driving, before taking your road test.
- Cell phones and other wireless communication devices cannot be used while driving except in emergencies.



# **Scheduling sessions:**

Our lessons are structured in two hour increments and are progressive. We typically like to schedule one session a week for the beginner driver. This will allow the parents to practice with their teen in between lessons based on the material covered in the previous session.

We schedule the first four sessions based on:

- I. The amount of time the student has held their Learners Permit.
- 2. Driving practice with parent/guardian.
- 3. Students availability.

# **Scheduling the Final Eval**

The fifth session is schedule when the instructor determines the student is ready, for instance at the end of lesson four your students instructor will email recommendations like 15 additional driving hours with parent/guardian is recommend. Please continue to practice the areas that are recommended in the fourth Eval sheet.

The student should be exhibiting independent driving skills before scheduling the fifth session.

The student has to pass the Final Evaluation with a score of 80% or greater.

If the student passes the Final Evaluation their Certificate of Completion is submitted to ADOT electronically. ADOT recommends allowing 48 hours for processing the certificate before it becomes available at the MVD or Third Party Providers.



#### RESTRICTIONS DURING THE FIRST 6 MONTHS (class G, under 18):

- Do not drive from 12am to 5am unless a legal guardian with a valid drivers license is seated beside you or you are driving from a sanctioned schoolsponsored activity, place of employment, a sanctioned religious activity, or family emergency.
- O Do not drive with more than one passenger under 18, unless the passengers are your siblings or you are driving with a parent or legal guardian who has a valid license and is seated beside you.
- Cell phones and other wireless devices cannot be used while driving except an audible navigation system (programming while driving is prohibited).



Upon successful completion of the driving course Arizona Driver Training Academy will email an Insurance Certificate to you, for a discount on your auto insurance.

If the student does not successfully pass the Final Eval, you have the opinion to purchase an additional two hour session which would include an overall review of 90 minutes and a 30 minute retest for \$99.00

You also have the opinion to test at the States testing site after additional practice with parent/guardian.

## **CANCELING A SESSION**

Cancelling a driving session without a 24 hour notice will result in a \$30.00 fee.

If the instructor is at the designated pick up point and the student isn't there or doesn't show up after 15 minutes a fee of \$30.00 will occur. The fee needs to be paid on or before the next session.

Please be aware the instructor may have travel time between students. Please allow a 5 minute window before and after your scheduled time.

# How our course works:

Thank you for enrolling in Arizona Driver Training Academy. Learning to drive can be intimidating, but it doesn't have to be. Our state licensed instructors are here for you and your teen every step of the way to make this process as stress free as possible.

The course is a total of 10 hours of driving lessons broken up into 5-two hour driving sessions.

If your student is under the age of 18 with a learners permit, in order to receive the training Certificate of Completion, also known as the Road Test Waiver your student will be required to complete 30 hours of driving practice with parent/guardian. The 30 hours is broken up into 10 hours of night time driving and 20 hours of daytime driving. The 10 hours of driving lessons can count towards those 30 hours.

#### LESSON ONE

Goes over vehicle familiarization, vision points, search patterns, and vehicle handling which includes smooth acceleration, smooth stopping, Right and Left turns, as well as neighborhood/low traffic driving environments and parking maneuvers.

#### **LESSON TWO:**

The first 30 minutes of the lesson are review of lesson one. As your student progresses through the lesson, we will cover neighborhood/low traffic areas Right and Left turns at intersections, lane changing and merging, lane control, speed control. Parking maneuvers.

#### LESSON THREE:

Is multi-lane two way streets, traffic awareness, lane centering, lane changing, merging, practicing alternating Right and Left turns, U-Turns, 3 Point turn with cones, Parallel parking.

#### LESSON FOUR:

First 30 minutes review, and introduction to freeway, on and off ramps, merging and exiting the freeway, visual points, traffic awareness, speed control, lane centering and lane changing.

#### **LESSON FIVE:**

The first 45 minutes is used for a destination lesson, your students instructor will give your student a destination to make a driving route from your home, or our office to a designated point, such as a mall or shopping area. During this exercise your student will demonstrate independent driving skills and strategies with no reminders from the instructor. Your student will need to exhibit independent driving skills to proceed to the Final Evaluation.

#### FINAL EVALUATION:



The Final Evaluation will cover a vehicle inspection, 3 point turn with cones, Final Evaluation Route.

The student will start with 100 points, deductions resulting from an infraction will be totaled at the end of the Evaluation, the student needs 80% to successfully complete and receive the certificate of completion.

Your instructor will make notes on the student drive sheet and email it to the parent/student email at the end of each lesson. The recommendations the instructor gives the student to practice, are important areas to continue practice in! Parents please practice driving with your student to help strengthen the driving skills put into place. Have your student keep track of their driving hours on the drive log sheet and turn it into the instructor on the last lesson.

Attached are driving concepts for your student to review. If you have any questions please give our office a call.

Left turns: 1. Signal your intention to turn. 2. Slow down/ or stop if the light is red. 3. Scan for pedestrians ,bicycles and other traffic in your intended path of travel. 4. When appropriate time and space is available at the intersection, proceed through the turn into the proper lane. 5. accelerate up to the speed limit.

Right turns: 1. Signal your intention to turn. 2. Slow down to 10-12mph or STOP if the light is red. 3. Scan for pedestrians ,bicycles and other traffic left, right, left and into your intended path of travel. 4. When appropriate time and space is available at the intersection, proceed through the turn into the proper lane. 5. accelerate up to the speed limit.

At a T-intersection with no Stop sign, stop, scan left, right, ahead and left again, when the intersection is clear of traffic and pedestrians proceed through with caution!

Review road signs with your student. Explain that some road signs are repetitive, but to continue to scan the signs ahead for anything that could be changing in the driving environment.

Scan ahead 30 seconds.

Practice: stop signs, yielding at T-intersections, one-way stop, two-way stop, all-way stop, speed limit, warning signs, and merging.
