

Article 14. Penalties.

Section 14.01 Any user who is found to have violated an order of the Authority or who willfully or negligently fails to comply with any provision of these Rules and the orders, rules, regulations and permits issued hereunder shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to a fine of not more than One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days. Each day on which a violation shall occur or continue to occur shall be deemed a separate and distinct offense.

Section 14.02 In addition to the penalties provided herein, the Authority may recover penalties, damages, costs, reasonable attorney's fees, court costs, court reporter's fees and other expenses of litigation by appropriate suit at law against the person or user found to have violated these Rules or the orders, rules, regulations and permits issued hereunder.


Section 14.03 In addition to proceeding under any other remedy available, either under these Rules or at law or equity, the Authority may assess a civil penalty upon an industrial user for the violation of these Rules or the orders, rules, regulations and permits issued hereunder in accordance with the Publicly Owned Treatment Works Penalty Law, 35 P.S. 752.1, et seq. The civil penalty shall not exceed Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars per day for each violation. Each violation for each separate day shall constitute a separate and distinct offense under these Rules.
