
June Meeting Summary: For June, the WOTM approved \$50 for Scholarships & Maintenance; \$250 to Feed a Home and collected \$39 for endowment. We agreed to donated \$100 to Garner Construction to benefit their Alzheimer's fundraiser and we decided to be a \$1,000 sponsor at the Mechanicsville Optimist Club's Hope & Harmony event, August 9 that will benefit pediatric patients at the Emergency Department in Medstar St. Mary's Hospital. See flyer pg. 4. We also donated to the MD/DC/DE Moose Assoc. \$500 for Comfort Cases, for children in foster care to carry their belongings in, along with 2 boxes of Tommy Moose stuffed animals. 
