Transposium Update by Cynthia Phillips

- Everything is on target for the June 23-26 Transposium at the Convention Center on the riverfront in Wilmington, NC. The trade show is scheduled for 6/25/2025.

DPI Updates

Lurrently, in the state of North Carolina there are 11,000 school bus routes, 17,000 buses on the road, and 29,000 school bus drivers.

DMV Updates – Bill and Barbara

- School bus driver classes and renewals are planned throughout the summer. During the 2024-2025 school year there were 2,239 newly licensed school bus drivers, 4,240 renewals, 656 no shows and 80 people that failed.
- → DMV has introduced a new initiative. Trainers will begin going paperless and utilizing a web-based service. This will allow for more training time with drivers.
- Two more training buses have been added for a total of 5 in the state. The training buses are located in Stedman, Greensboro, Buncombe, Wake and Statesville. This is a benefit for charter and private schools.

Update - Derek Graham

■ Edulog has been meeting with the TIMS staff weekly about the ATHENA routing system. ATHENA is a cloud-based system that does not operate off local servers. Additional information will be provided at the Transposium.
