

7. Offset Alley Maneuver

Purpose

To evaluate a competitor's ability to maneuver through two (2) offset lanes with a minimum of hesitation and without touching the barriers or flag tips.

Instructions

Two sets of parallel barriers are set up with flag tips positioned twelve inches away from the barriers. The direction of the offset is right.

Scoring

The following demerits will be deducted from the *Maximum Score* for infractions:

Outside Judge

- 35 demerits Touching the barriers (not flag tips), Backing during the event, Failure to complete the event.
- 5 demerits Each instance of stopping the forward motion of the bus (agreed on by all judges at that event) (maximum of 15 demerits)
- 4 demerits Each instance of touching any of the flag tips (maximum of 28 demerits)

Inside Judge

- 35 demerits Failure to properly wear a seat belt, Failure to remain fully seated during the event, Failure to keep door closed during event.

Maximum Score

Thirty-five (35) points






8. Right Turn




7. Offset Alley



6. Railroad Crossing




