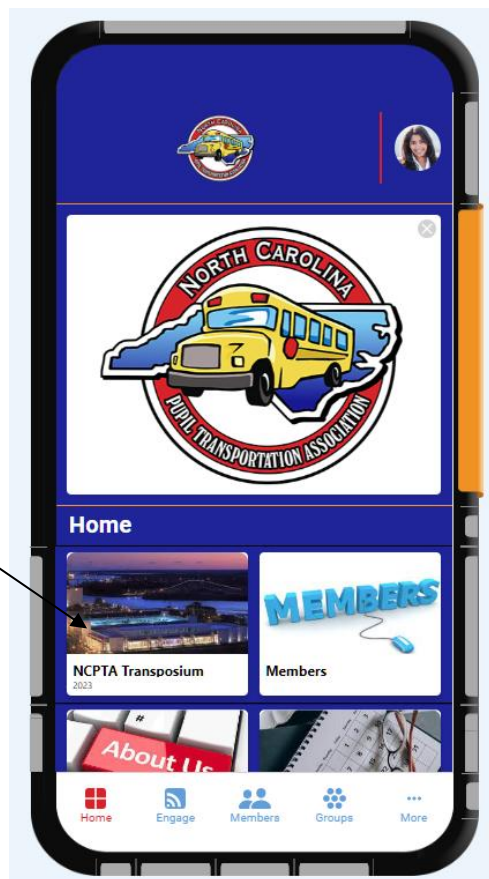
The credit hours for each session are built in the APP. There is a session survey you may complete for each session.

This should allow adequate time.

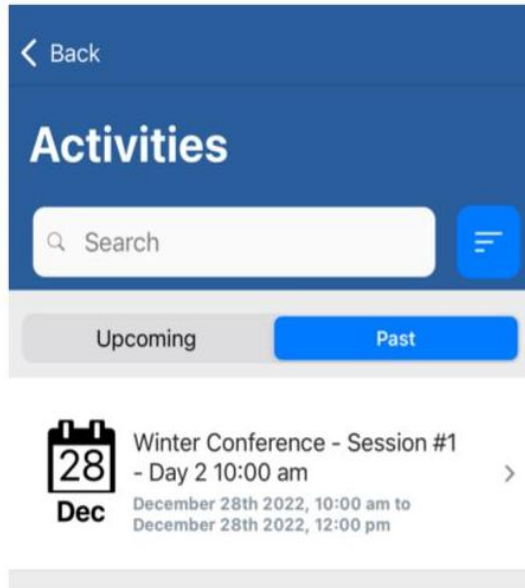

How to Check-In to an Activity

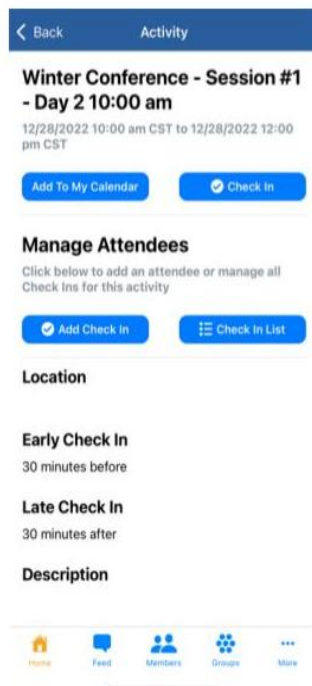
After you've created your check-in, your users will be able to check in.

NOTE: You can also view session activities from the event schedule.

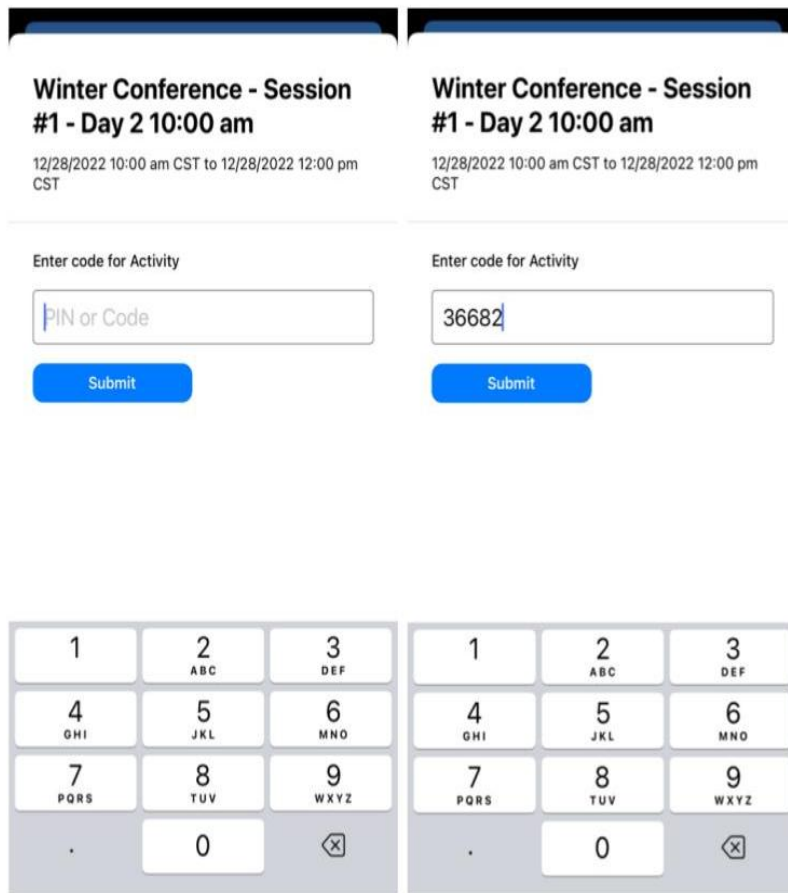


2. View Activity details. From here, you can add the activity to your calendar, view check-in times (including early and late check-in), view the location, and view the description.

Click on "Check-In".

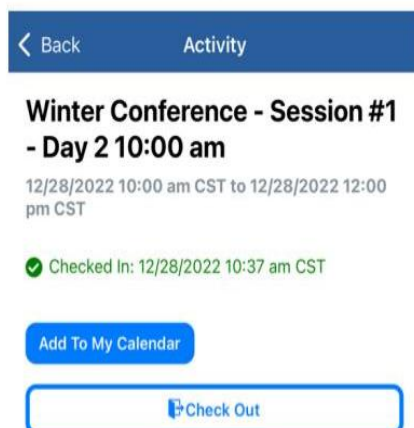


- From here, the app will prompt users to check-in using the predetermined check-in method. The check-in method here is a 5 digit code.
