
North Carolina School Bus Electrification Announcement



The North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is providing outreach for superintendents, fleet managers and other transportation personnel at public schools to increase interest and awareness of the availability of electric school bus replacement funding through the NC Volkswagen (VW) Settlement Program.

NC Volkswagen School Bus Program

VW school bus funding may cover up to 100% of the cost for electrification of a school bus in North Carolina. Replacement buses must be diesel engine model years 2009 and older.
