- TD-10 due next week, 1st step of bus replacement normal practices with the TD-10 now.
- Stop arm camera allotment will go out soon.
- Enhanced stop arm allotment 61 applied 57 awarded and submitted.
- Equipment contingency closed today will be submitted next week.
- Small fuel allotment- no documents will be required.
- All leftover funding has to go out by the end of March. It will be related to budget rating and efficiency.
- Bid for the new school bus is ongoing and will be used for the next year orders.
- Finance agreement still pending.
- 30-day inspection committee selected to go over the 30-day manual.
- Not much on a Legislative front at this point. New session to start in April 2024.

DMV Report by Terry Fuller (20 years DMV experience)

- Department moving in the right direction, salary analysis to increase current positions and help attract new staff.
- 1 position open- some staff out on WC.
- Department has purchased 3 new school buses to help with training.
- Virtual training continuing to improve
- Virtual training had 1900 participants with a 84 % passing rate.

- Together with both virtual and in person over 3000 participants.
- Now the School Bus Traffic and Safety Department reports directly to the DMV Commissioner
