

Down But Not Out

Scriptures Psalms 42:5-6 & 43:5, 2 Corinthians 4:8-9

Each day we are faced with different circumstances and situations where decisions must be made. These issues often affect us and others long term, which may cause us mental anguish as we wrestle or fight to win the war against the enemy of positive confession and biblical truths.

In Psalms 42 the psalmist asked a question of his self, acknowledging his current state of mind. Then he states that he is cast down, the Hebrew word is "shachach" meaning to sink or depress, to bend down or humble self. This may indicate that David composed this psalm while fleeing from Absalom his son and enemy. You can imagine the pain and anguish he was in dealing with a situation such as this. But David reminds himself of his source and help. Praise God. He calls to remembrance a large sacred mountain forming the southern portion of the Anti-Lebanon range, the summit of which consists of 3 peaks which are rarely free of snow. The cool heights condense the moisture of the atmosphere so rapidly that mists fall frequently and cover the mountain. Dew is so thick at night as to be like rain. The upper part is bare, but the slopes are covered

with vegetation. He goes from dryness and drought to refreshing water and growth. As the song says, "From sinking sand you lifted me, from shades of night to the bright light."

In Psalms 43 David ask the question again and this time states that his very being is disquieted (anxious, uneasy, restless, dissatisfied). Yet again he reminds himself to praise God who is the salvation of his countenance. If we look to Yeshua (Jesus) our outlook changes and so does our appearance. What is that part of you where he abides?

2 Corinthians, Paul acknowledges the changes in our mental and emotional outlook. But he lets us know that they are temporal not eternal. When there is a physical fight many times one opponent is knocked down. But he is given an opportunity to rise during the count down time. If he rises before the count is finished he is not defeated. And in many instances has risen to defeat his opponent and become the victor. But he must be focused on the prize, determined, physically prepared and mentally convinced that he is a winner.

We are in the spiritual boxing ring. We cannot discredit our opponent. We must be alert, watchful, prepared to take some blows, but strong enough to fight back. We must have some spiritual muscle behind each punch we throw. Know our source of

strength and help. Remember that the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds......

There are times when you will go down.

Acknowledge it, but don't stay there. Get up the count is not over. You are more than a conqueror through Jesus who loves you and gave Himself a ransom for you. Chose to wake up, look up, and move up to the higher elevations where there is refreshing water and continual growth.
