The Thailand Concordia Lutheran Church (TCLC) recently celebrated its 20th year by inviting neighboring country Lutheran leaders to join them in celebration and mission collaboration! Nearly 150 friends gathered from

Thailand, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar, Vietnam, Malaysia, Singapore, Philippines, Korea, and Indonesia. Other ministry partners from the USA and Canada were present, as well.

This anniversary provided the chance to learn about each country's unique ministries, challenges, and iovs. The group traveled to 3 locations in Thailand-Bangkok, Phuket, and Chiang Mai – while enjoying the cultural nuances, foods, and beauty of each area. Rev. Dr. Tom Zelt provided meaningful keynote messages on the "Uncompromised Gospel" as he used his extensive archeological background to encourage the participants and to lead discussions on the challenges and opportunities in ministry today.





TCLC President, Rev. Dr. Ted NaThalang shared, "We Lutherans are a small number in the world, especially in Asia, therefore, it is very important that we get to know each other so that we may have opportunities to partner and collaborate for His mission to seek and save the lost. God has given each one of us unique gifts and talents, and when we put all those things together, great things can happen for the expansion of His kingdom."

The Ehlers worked with Ted and Gunya NaThalang as LCMS missionaries in Thailand in the '90s, leading to the formation of Garuna (2001) and the Luther Institute-SE Asia (2006) after the Ehlers returned to the USA. Garuna's purpose is to serve the local churches in the region.

Pastor Niran Temsakun, Garuna's Luther Institute-Thailand director shared, "It was a truly enriching experience, where I had the opportunity to learn from many people, make new friends from Southeast Asia, and be inspired by the various ministries." Pastor Bun Phanna serves as the Director of the Luther Institute-Cambodia. He shared. "This was helpful because I was able to see that theological education (LISA) and Christian schools (Bible Teaching, Bible Study & Sunday Schools) are crucially important as we want to expand the Gospel and Lutheran churches in Southeast Asia."

There were 110 Cambodian teens gathered at the 1st annual Cambodian Lutheran Church youth camp this fall. These young people gathered from throughout the country enjoying 3 days of Bible study, worship, games, fellowship and fun. Camper Sreylin, a Garuna Christian School graduate and now a teacher aide at GCS 7 shared, "The youth camp helped me hear the Gospel and taught me about the Word of Jesus, which made me feel like I was getting something new for my life through the Word of God. I was so happy when I heard the Gospel of Jesus." This camp was jointly funded by Garuna, LCMS World Mission, and the Lutheran Church-Canada.

In Cambodia, it is time to register for the new school year. Garuna currently enrolls over 1700 students in 9 schools, but expects to be near 2000 with the opening of school #10 this month. Parents are excited to enroll their children. Somny shared, "I am so happy that my daughter is admitted to study at Garuna Christian School #4. According to my observation, the Garuna teachers
