The most recent Garuna journey provided an opportunity to visit northern Thailand exploring opportunities to expand current work with the hilltribe people groups on the borders. There is great interest in Garuna's Luther Institute — Southeast Asia (LISA) Bible training program which is very capably led by Pastor Niran who leads the LISA — Thailand program. There is great receptivity as the Good News spreads outward from northern Thailand because LISA students have freedom to share with friends and families in more restricted areas. Our Thai partners confirmed that LISA courses are much needed and loved!

It was an amazing time to visit about ways in which Garuna can support the expansion of LISA training as these Thailand Concordia Lutheran Churches (TCLC) are seeing growth and much interest in the Gospel.
