Garuna Christian Schools Return To In-Person Learning

As of November 2020, all 6 schools are meeting on campus, with added health protocols. We see attendance numbers returning to pre-COVID days. School was never fully "cancelled"; instead, our teachers went out to visit/teach at student homes from April through October! In fact, we are gearing up for a January 2021 "new school year" start. At that time, our students move up a grade level. We just ordered 1,232 uniforms and backpacks, expecting our highest enrollment ever! Happy New Year!

We Have A Problem

Jeff and Cheryl were on an early morning Zoom call with Garuna's Cambodia Director of Education, Phanna (Peter). As they discussed many details of ministry there, Peter mentioned that the Cambodian leadership team had recently visited Garuna Christian School #6 in Siem Reap. He said, "I'm worried..." Those are words you don't want to hear.

He proceeded to say, "I'm worried that we have too many kids who want to come to our school. After our Garuna teachers visited and taught in the student homes during the quarantine, we have become more 'exposed." (He meant that in a good way). He added, "Everyone knows about us. They feel we have proper teaching at our Garuna Christian School, and they feel very happy and safe."

We'll take that problem any day...and thank God that this Good News continues to be seen, felt, and "heard" in Southeast Asia. That is exactly the message of Christmas, isn't it? We had a problem (called sin) and Jesus came to earth to save us. He is Immanuel-God with Us! No quarantine or illness can keep us from God's love. His love is exactly the medicine that we need – through faith in the Christ-child!

The goal of this process is to refine and strengthen the core curriculum with a view of making it accessible online for even more students. GCU – Master's Degree Update

Garuna's Luther Institute Southeast Asia (LISA) is working in close partnership with Grand Canyon University's College of Theology to offer GCU's online MA in Christian Ministry degree to qualified students from our partners in Asia. GCU and Garuna are currently working on the process of enrolling students, selecting our Lutheran professors, and preparing the courses for a January starting date. This is an amazing opportunity to bring important theological training to our leaders in the region. Garuna is very grateful to GCU and its leaders for their wonderful cooperation and hard work to bring this study opportunity to many. Please pray for the success of this ministry.
