These generous gifts paid for the new** building, furnishings, and related Bible training expenses. It was an exciting day in Phnom Penh, Cambodia!

NEW MASTER'S DEGREE COMPLETION!

In a unique partnership between the College of Theology at Grand Canyon University (GCU) and Garuna Ministries, the M.A. in Christian Ministry degree was awarded on January 8 to six graduates. These Lutheran leaders are from Cambodia, Indonesia, Papua, New Guinea, and the class mentor is from the USA. After 2 years of study, a special service and commencement celebration was held in Phnom Penh, Cambodia for the graduates who could attend. Special thanks to GCU and the Lutheran professors who taught the classes. There are plans to continue this partnership to further prepare leaders for Lutheran churchwork throughout the world!

NEW SCHOOL YEAR BEGINS!

Approximately 1,300 students are currently registered for the new academic year at the 7 Garuna Christian Schools in Cambodia. These students are registered for grades K-6. They have the opportunity to learn about Jesus every day and are hearing about the Resurrection and promise of eternal life, as well!



NEW TWO SCHOOLS UNDER CONSTRUCTION!

The work continues on the construction of Garuna Christian Schools #8 and #9. These schools should be completed by early fall, with dedications scheduled for January 2024. These dedications will be attended by members/leaders of sponsoring churches in Fremont, CA, and an Omaha area coalition of 9 churches and the Concordia Schools of Omaha.



NEW RIBBON CUTTING EVENTS!

Garuna Christian School #7 in Phnom Penh was dedicated in early January. The village chief cut the ribbon and encouraged his mostly Buddhist community to send their children to the school. He said his 4 grandchildren attend and are enjoying the teaching, love, and care they receive from the faculty there. A few days later, another Garuna School classroom was dedicated in Siem Reap. This school is operated by Garuna, but funded by Prince of Peace Lutheran Church and School in Fremont, CA. The original school was dedicated in 2019, but an additional classroom was added this past year to accommodate additional students. Enrollment here totals over 320.

Garuna reaches out to children in Chiang Mai, Thailand through activities in the government schools. It's a blessing to be invited to come on campus to teach English and music classes that include Bible lessons. There are also plans to develop Garuna Kids Bible Clubs and adult Bible training for hilltribe communities along the borders of Thailand.





NEW TRANSPORTATION!

"Can my village children come to study at the Garuna Christian School?" This request came to Garuna from Deaconess Hem Horn who has been studying in Garuna's Luther Institute Southeast Asia (LISA) Bible program for a number of years. Children from her Sunday School wanted the opportunity to join the Garuna Kids in Garuna's school in Kampot, Cambodia. The problem: They live too far away to ride bikes or walk, but they really want to come to school and learn about Jesus.

Solution: A "school bus" and driver were hired and as many as 30 new students now travel daily to hear about Jesus! What a wonderful journey! In addition, the bus driver wants to join Garuna's LISA Bible training classes in the new year!
