Summer travels are nearing an end, and now it's "back to school" time in the USA! Join us as we share about the **exciting year-round**learning journey in Southeast Asia as children and adults are learning about Jesus every day and in many ways! These large crowds are excitedly receiving and growing in the grace and knowledge of their Savior Jesus!



ALL ABOARD...for the opening of the two newest Garuna Christian Schools (GCS) in Cambodia. August marks the first days of registration and classes for GCS 8 and GCS 9, with expectations of 200 new students at each school. This Garuna school ministry will now touch the lives of 1700 Garuna Kids and their families.



DEPARTURE DATE: JANUARY 2024. The 2 new schools will be officially dedicated in January when leaders from the supporting churches in Omaha, NE and Fremont, CA travel together for a trip to meet their Garuna Kids, see their schools, and celebrate with their communities!



The families come to register their children at the new Garuna Schools. Students pay no tuition. They are funded by Garuna Kid sponsorships!!



Welcome home! 97% of the families in rural Cambodia are Buddhist, but they are quick to register for Garuna's schools. They appreciate the Bible teaching, and they love and trust the teaching staff as they join the school family.

ARE WE THERE YET? The COVID pandemic slowed down these two projects, but everyone has been patient as the construction crews in Cambodia have been working hard to complete these projects so that students in grades K-6 can begin to learn about Jesus every day of the year! **Did you know that the Garuna Schools do not take a long summer break or vacation?** This extra time in class is beneficial for many reasons! The kids continue to learn and grow, and the parents can continue to work and provide for their families, knowing their kids are loved and safe.



BUCKLE UP...IT'S A NEW DESTINATION! Garuna has decided

to move its Thailand gospel outreach from Bangkok to Chiang Mai. Plans are being made to purchase a site and to move/add staff to work in a collaborative manner from this northern Thailand hub. Besides work in the Chiang Mai area, Garuna will continue to reach into nearby closed countries and the hilltribe groups near the border. Currently, Garuna has work in this region, but with increasing invitations and opportunities, a more centralized team and approach will be a new focus. It's an exciting new opportunity. CRUISIN' TO SCHOOL. Students

in the Minnesota South District of the LCMS will be focusing on the Garuna Kids this year for their annual Hearts for Jesus Fundraiser. They have chosen to help provide classroom desks/furnishings and transportation for the kids in Cambodia! We love working with all the kids in the USA to make missions relevant and "real" — even though half world away!

WINDOW SEAT. Garuna's new Teacher Aide program is off and running as Garuna Kid graduates have a "window seat" to leadership development. Each Garuna school has received applications from graduating 6th graders who want to continue to be involved at their alma mater as a teacher aide. Garuna's Education Director, Pastor Peter said, "These students have many memories of their years at their Garuna school as they have learned both general knowledge and the Bible. Many of them heard the Gospel and believed that Jesus is their God." Approximately 50 young people are now part of this pilot program, as they help the younger students, join in weekly Bible study, help with Sunday School, learn about teaching, and are encouraged to further their education. Pray that these continuing connections will result in growing faith and future Garuna Christian School teacher recruitment!



A flight is only as good as its crew....and the Garuna Schools are only as good as their teachers. Elen Tong is an excellent teacher at the GCS 6 school in Siem Reap, Cambodia, serving 320 students. She serves as the vice principal and English teacher. On Sundays, she helps with the Sunday School program with approximately 150 of the Garuna Kids attending. In June, Elen shared her thanks for the opportunity she has as a Garuna teacher, serving in a ministry role she loves.



hardship, including a shortage of food, no money, no clothes, and no transportation to attend school. She didn't complete 9th grade. Instead, she dropped out and went to live with her older sister. She worked as a cleaner at a Christian school, and the more she watched the teachers, the more she longed to do the same. She became a Christian and was able to go to a Bible school for a short time before she was married. She then served in several schools. Even though she and her husband were working, it was still difficult to make ends meet.

Elen began to work for Garuna in 2018 when she and her husband were hired to teach at Garuna Christian School #6. She joyfully (and tearfully) said, "It made me feel that God gave me a chance to serve him again. Now that I work with Garuna, my family is better both physically and spiritually. Garuna has also helped the community by providing education to children, especially the children who study in our school and hear the Gospel every day." Elen shared that she's seen that the student families are positive about sending their children to school and Sunday School, listening to their kids singing and hearing the Bible stories, too

In summary, Elen feels that school is a great place for sharing the Gospel in Cambodia. The parents are able to go to work and know that their children are learning and growing in the nurture and safety of the Garuna schools and staff. She now serves at the Garuna school with her husband as principal. He is also in charge of the second school in the region, opening this fall. Two of her brothers and a nephew are also teaching at the school. Her family certainly has a heart and a gift for sharing the Gospel with children and families who have never heard the Good News. Elen loves Matthew 6:33-34, "but seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. Therefore, do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."

FROM THE CHAIRMAN: Raise Your Hand!

"Because, if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved, ... For 'everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.'" Romans 10:9.10.13

Dear Friends in Christ,

Do you remember your teachers asking you to raise your hand before you speak? If you knew the answer to their question you might wiggle your arm or stand up at your desk to get the teacher's attention. Or, if you didn't know the answer you might try to hide behind a classmate so the teacher couldn't see that you didn't know the answer.

In this newsletter **our theme is "Journeys with Jesus...Learning and Growing"**. The purpose of Garuna's ministry in Southeast Asia is reflected in the passage from Romans chapter 10. It is to bring the Good News of Jesus to the region where less than 1% of the population believe in Jesus.

Our initial student enrollment at our 9 Garuna schools reflects that percentage. But thanks be to God, our leaders report to us that after their daily Bible study of God's Word, the vast majority "raise their

hands" when asked if they believe in Jesus! In the photo, I was leading a devotion with the children at the Garuna Christian School in Phnom Penh, and I asked them to raise their hand if they

believed in Jesus. WOW! I was so blessed and full of joy to see almost every hand shoot up with delight and enthusiasm.

Paul teaches us that the gift of salvation is by God's grace, and we testify to that faith He gives us by "confessing' with



our mouth that Jesus is Lord and "believing" in our hearts that God raised Him from the dead. It is His promise that "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved"! Let's join the children by raising our hands to that wonderful promise.

Thank you for your prayers and very generous support of Garuna and its ministry of bringing this Gospel to Southeast Asia. May we lift up our hands in faith and in praise to our Lord who allows us the opportunity to bring Good News to children and their families in such a place.
