Garuna recently celebrated 20 years of ministry. The ministry was founded by Rev. Dr. Jeff Ehlers and mission partners in 2001, after returning to Arizona following 8 years of missionary service in Bangkok, Thailand. Garuna came into being at the request of the local Asian Lutheran Christians who asked for training to prepare them for church leadership and for help with outreach and ministry projects. We thank our friends and partners around the world for the prayers, finances, and other assistance given over this time, and we praise God for his presence and blessing during these 20 years!

Asian Students Helping Asian Students

This summer, 10 students from **Concordia International School Shanghai** served a month-long internship with Garuna. These high school students worked with Garuna's teams in the US and Cambodia to create promotional videos and resources to use in the Garuna Christian School classrooms, including Bible story books and English/Art activities linked to the Bible lessons. Concordia International School Shanghai students have been partnering with Garuna for several years now, participating in family and student trips to Garuna's schools in Cambodia and sharing resources to benefit their Asian neighbors.

The offerings given were used to purchase the new school desks and furnishings for Garuna Christian School #7 which is opening soon in Phnom Penh!

concluded a post-Easter fundraising campaign to build their second Garuna Christian School in Siem Reap, Cambodia. The results were revealed on Pentecost Sunday and the congregation rejoiced in the fact that they met and far exceeded their goal for the building of Garuna Christian School #8! The land has been purchased, the plans are finalized, and the construction bids are coming in. The building should be completed in 2022, hoping to reach another 200+ kids and families with the Gospel!



Rev. Dr. Tom Zelt kicked off the fundraising campaign in April. Former member Mr. Scott Wollberg visited that day to learn more about Prince of Peace's partnership with Garuna. Scott, Operations Director at Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church (Omaha) took the idea back home and began a new partnership initiative with friends in Omaha, NE.

Amazing friends in Omaha, Nebraska are joining together to make a difference in Cambodia, too. In the spirit of cooperation, leaders from Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church and King of Kings Church formed the "Omaha Partner Churches for Garuna Christian Schools in Cambodia" coalition, including the Concordia Mustangs who are students of Concordia Academy and the Jr./Sr. High of Omaha. This *round-up* of missional Christians in Omaha want to build Garuna Christian School #9 and this group has already purchased the land for this school. It's so exciting to include the K-12 students and families in this project, as well!

School Districts Helping Garuna's "School System"

This past spring, the district education execs from the **Michigan and South Wisconsin Districts** asked if they could partner with Garuna in the 2021-2022 school year. That was an incredibly easy "YES"! The goal for these Lutheran schools is to raise funds to build 2 new classrooms at the Garuna Christian School #1 site, located in eastern Cambodia, near the border of Vietnam. This school was built in 2013 and has outgrown their original site. They also want to add a new kindergarten program. In the spirit of "collaboration" (and a bit of fun), district education execs Chris Cody and Travis Grulke have challenged the other to meet and exceed the goals set for themselves, hoping each district can fund 1 classroom each! These Michigan and Wisconsin students will have the opportunity to see weekly updates of "their" new school building as it is constructed in the coming months.

Online Partnerships

Grand Canyon University's (GCU) College of Theology in Phoenix, AZ has partnered with Garuna in offering its **online master's degree in Christian Ministry** to a group of our Asian leaders. This online learning method is wonderful as the students may combine ministry and studies, with immediate application to their current ministries. This practical 10-course program is nearing the halfway point and includes ministry leaders in Southeast Asian countries.

The benefits are many as the professors are selected by Garuna and the students may remain in their home countries. In a June 2, 2021, GCU Today article, Dr. Peter Anderson (Assistant Dean for the College of Theology) said, "It's actually a really unique setup where we are able to bring on adjuncts who understand Lutheran-specific dynamics for leading congregations and also understand Southeast Asia," Anderson said.

Cambodian Partners

God is blessing His Word in the country of Cambodia. Garuna partners with the **Cambodia Lutheran Church (CLC) and LISA Cambodia, as it operates the Garuna Christian School (GCS) system** there. This collaborative effort is a wonderful partnership that God is blessing with many opportunities to share the Good News with children and their families, resulting in many baptisms, new church plants, and outreach opportunities. It has been a blessing for LISA Cambodia to



offer frequent teaching and training courses for the indigenous leaders of the congregations and schools.

Despite travel restrictions, the amazingly dedicated and talented Garuna Cambodian Organization's (GCO) leadership team has continued to grow and guide the ministries in their country. Led by Pastor Peter (middle left), his team has managed well. Regular Zoom calls and emails between the Garuna USA team have been added to their agendas during the past 18 months.

Dr. Jason Hiles, Dean of GCU's College of Theology shared that he and Dr. Peter Anderson had talked for several years about the possibility of working with international students in a specific cohort, teaching material for a specific denomination – in the case of Garuna, Lutheran. After watching the students interact in their online classes, Dr. Hiles shared in the same GCU Today article, "They're all smiling, they're talking. You're all of a sudden looking into a window that has you



in another part of the world...(leaders) being trained specifically to serve in those contexts. We couldn't have been more excited. We felt like we were part of something that was bigger than ourselves."

College of Theology Dean Dr. Jason Hiles and his staff had been looking for a way to incorporate a specific international cohort.



Garuna's Luther Institute Southeast Asia (LISA) Training Ministry

In the past 18 months, Covid-19 travel restrictions have resulted in some new LISA delivery models. **LISA's Thailand country coordinator, Pastor Niran Temsakun**, recently shared that the quarantine has resulted in his having more time to create an online studio and develop online classes. He and his fellow LISA graduates continue to reach out to Thai Christians, but are also finding an openness among non-believers, as well. Online prayer requests are shared, worship is available, and weekly Bible classes are being shared with groups as large as 45 in a class. This tool has allowed



Pastor Niran's team to work with hilltribes and evangelists in regions that might otherwise be more difficult to access. They also have plans to conduct 20-hour Reformation course in the month of October led by Thai pastors. Praise God for blessings through challenges!

Despite the challenges of a global pandemic, Garuna's ministry partners have been blessed by the opportunity to use new technology delivery systems to share the Gospel with many more people. Pastor Niran Temsakun has used his technology skills to expand the ministry.
