


# There May Be A Pandemic, BUT...

## Look What God Is Doing An Amazing Opportunity for Theological Training

During this time of quarantine, a new partnership between Garuna's Luther Institute Southeast Asia (LISA) program and Grand Canyon University (GCU) in Phoenix has been developing. For many years, the very capable and dedicated Asian graduates of the LISA program have been asking for an online MA in Theology. They have been serving as country leaders in ministry and wanted to be better prepared for their roles.

It's happening! GCU has very graciously agreed to undertake a Pilot Project with Garuna to offer an MA degree in Christian Ministry through GCU's College of Theology. It is an accredited degree with the 10 classes

taught by qualified Lutheran professors recommended by Garuna. Our Asian leaders will be able to apply this education and field experiences to benefit their ministries and in their teaching for LISA. Garuna will be inviting 12-15 Lutheran leaders from countries in Asia to participate, with classes starting in January 2021. Currently, the Asian students in this pilot project are working on preparing for their English language proficiency test which is a prerequisite for acceptance into GCU.

Please keep GCU, Garuna, and our students in your prayers as this opportunity has tremendous potential for the spreading of the Gospel in Asia through our Lutheran partners there. We are very grateful for the wonderful and cordial working relationship with GCU's leadership in helping make this dream a reality.

## Look What God Is Doing Indigenous Leaders are Leading!

Does a pandemic stop the sharing of God's Word and the work of His people? By NO MEANS! Some might worry about the ongoing ministry of Garuna's programs without visits from the USA team during this pandemic. However, our leaders throughout Asia have demonstrated a wonderful dedication to

**WHAT IS THAT MODEL?** Provide Biblical, Lutheran training and opportunities to indigenous staff so that they can carry out the work in their own communities. The pandemic reminds us that this strategy is essential.

## Look What God Is Doing Home Visits by Garuna Teachers!

The Cambodian government closed schools during the pandemic, but they allow teachers to "go out" and visit students and families in smaller groups. Since April, that has been how the Garuna teachers are spending their teaching time. They are on the road, visiting students each day. The best part of that is that parents and non-Garuna Kid siblings are hearing the Gospel each day, too. This is a blessing in disguise. Our team tells us that these visits have further solidified the positive school-home relationships in this Buddhist culture.

As our teams visit student homes, they are also finding time to get parent impressions about the Garuna Christian School ministry. Parents commonly share feedback, such as *"I am really glad that my children are in Garuna Christian School where they learn a lot and are safe."* Another wrote, *"They are learning how to respect parents very much. I am happy to see this attitude taught to my kids."* One parent shared, *"I am very pleased to have my child in school because the staff is gentle and friendly with students and parents."*

The Garuna students are taught about Jesus. Even in a society that is 98% Buddhist, the majority of the families agreed with this comment, *"I know that this school is a Christian school. Even though I do not yet believe in Jesus, but I do not forbid my children to believe in Jesus Christ."* They expressed their appreciation for the recent home visits, too:

*"During this time, I am really happy when the teachers came down to help and give extra help to the my children during this Covid-19. I want both of my children to attend and finish their study in the Garuna Christian School."*

All of the Garuna Christian School teachers spent time during these past months cleaning and decorating their classrooms. In addition, 3 schools received tile flooring, all are in the process of building new handwashing facilities, trees and flowers were planted, repairs were made, gravel was added where needed, new restrooms were added, and a classroom expansion was completed. It was a real spring housecleaning time. In addition to home visits and cleaning, the faculty spent time in Bible study and prayer each week, as well.
