## GARUNA KIDS AND GARUNA CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS

A new school year is starting in Cambodia. November is "back to school" time and our students are advancing a grade level and receiving new uniforms, books, backpacks, and supplies. The Garuna Christian Schools are open year-round, but there is still something nice about new beginnings and fresh starts!

The Garuna Kids learn English, Khmer, Math, and Bible at the schools. The teachers are doing a great job of teaching in creative ways, using their resources wisely.

### **New School Coming Soon!**

Building plans are being finalized for the start of construction on GCS #7. This school is located on the outskirts of the capital city (Phnom Penh) and will serve as a headquarters for the Garuna ministry in Cambodia. There will be a school for 200-300 students



in K-6, offices, a church plant, and there is room on the property for future training facilities (LISA). Expected completion: Summer of 2020.

Garuna is thankful for Prince of Peace Lutheran Church and School in Fremont, California, for taking a significant partnership role with Garuna in helping develop Garuna Christian Schools and church planting in the Siem Reap area.

It's a Cambodian Christmas party at the GCS in Tbong Khmum. Each of the schools plan their own Christmas outreach celebration, inviting family and members of the village. At these events, the students sing, share traditional music and dance, enjoy food, and share the Christmas message. Last year over 2,000 people participated in the GCS Christmas outreach events. The decorations take on their own creative style – sometimes resembling typical red/green themes...or perhaps something more festive as is evident here. The message is the same: Jesus has come to save the world!
