A LIFE'S JOURNEY TOWARD JOY AND HOPE!

Niran Temsakun shares joy and smiles wherever he goes. He lives in northern Thailand with his wife, Esther, and son, Jabez. He is a pastor in the Thailand Concordia Lutheran Church (TCLC), and he serves as Garuna's Luther Institute-Thailand (LI-T) Bible training coordinator. He has amazing gifts, and he shares his joy and hope wherever he goes.

But his younger days were much different. As a young boy growing up in a Buddhist culture, it was common and even expected for boys to be ordained as youth monks. This is a way to honor one's parents and gain merit for oneself and the family. Niran was ordained twice between the ages of 13 and 15, during school breaks, for about a month and a half each time. "I had hoped it would bring clarity and peace, but I found no real answers — only a path of continual effort without assurance. There were no promises of forgiveness or hope beyond this life, only the pressure to keep trying and to be 'good enough'. I lived in fear, unsure if I would ever find a way to be free from guilt or to be accepted after death."

But by God's grace, Niran heard the Gospel. Through the preaching of a pastor, he learned that Jesus Christ is our Savior, and that we can receive forgiveness and new life — not because of what we do, but because of what He has done for us. That message brought him hope, freedom, and joy.

"I no longer live in fear but in the assurance of His grace and the promise of eternal life. **This new life in Christ has transformed me.** It is no longer about what I can do to reach heaven but about responding to His love by serving others and sharing His Good News with those still searching. I thank God every day for this gift, and I pray that many others in Thailand will come to know the same hope that only Jesus can give."



The name Niran literally means "one who is everlasting and never ending." Niran's joy is due to the promise of everlasting life from a Savior whose love for him is never ending. Pastor Niran is now ordained as a Lutheran pastor and shares Jesus with the people of his homeland – Thailand. And that he does with fervor and joy!





BURSTING WITH BAPTISM JOY

In the past few months, there were more than 90 baptisms among the 10 Garuna Christian Schools, Sunday Schools, and at Garuna's Luther Institute-Cambodia Center. Adults and children alike are eager to learn about Jesus and trust in His Resurrection promise. It is a great joy to see God's Word moving in a region where less than 2% trust in Jesus as their Savior!




BIBLE TEACHING SURGES IN ASIA

Garuna's Luther Institute-SE Asia (LISA) Bible classes have been taught in this region for over 20 years. They were originally taught by western instructors but are now taught by the indigenous leaders who are training the next generation of teachers. The LISA courses are being edited, formatted, and standardized. There is a growing demand around the world for its use. Rev. There are 304 students enrolled at this school, bringing the current Garuna system enrollment to 2,060 with 70 teachers. The community leaders and families are very excited and thankful for this opportunity in their village. And DFLC members are excited and thankful to provide this for them.

I cannot imagine the sadness of facing eternity without God's promises of forgiveness and eternal life with Him in paradise.

Recently, God called home a wonderful servant. Mr. Mayavuth was one of the first Garuna Christian School teachers. He taught since 2013 in Prey Veng, Cambodia and was instrumental in the school's formation and ministry. He loved Jesus. He loved sharing the Easter message with the children of his community. He tirelessly shared the love of Christ in Bible class each day and Sunday School classes each weekend. He loved God's Word and attended LISA classes faithfully. Selfishly, his passing felt bitter. We miss him.

I cannot imagine the **bitter** suffering and hardship Mayavuth endured in his early years during the very difficult Khmer Rouge era. But I can imagine the **sweet** joy he experienced when he learned of Jesus' love for him and the promise of eternal life in paradise.







Mayavuth knew and believed that Jesus is preparing a place for all who trust in Him (John 14:1-3), that He is coming back to take us to be with him (1 Thess. 4:14), and that our permanent home is heaven (Phil 3:20).

Imagine the joy we all will experience when Jesus calls us home and raises us from mortality to immortality with HIM in HIS Kingdom.

May our lives reflect the joy of the resurrection to others.
