## Domaine des Garriguettes

Cuvée Béret Bleu | AOC Côtes du Rhône



**Grape variety:** 100% Cinsault

**Vinification:** Pre-fermentation cold maceration, “Saignée” at 10%, gentle extraction by pumping over, 90% destemmed, 10% whole bunches, natural vinification (no inputs). Complete fermentation of 12 days. Aging on lees in concrete tank 90% and oak (demi-muid) 10% for about 5 months.

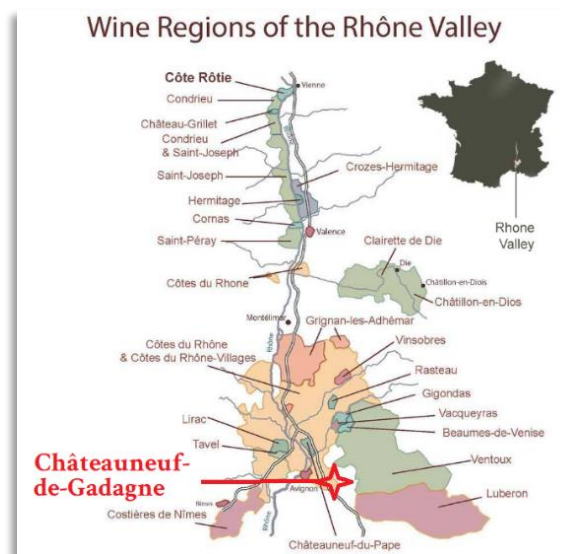
**Tasting notes:** This is a wine of great pleasure and delicacy, around notes of violets and small red fruits on a very elegant tannic structure. The mouth is juicy and fresh. To enjoy around a charcuterie board, during a barbecue of grilled meat. Serve slightly chilled around 14 to 16 degrees.

### The Grower

Sébastien Clément is a young wine grower in Châteauneuf-de-Gadagne, who has always worked for the family Domain, motivated by his passion for wine inherited from his ancestors and especially from his grandfather, Jean. He learned his trade with his father, Jean Louis, then trained and managed many vinifications in several countries around the world. He has always grown his grapevines with the same philosophy - a traditional production respecting nature and the cycle of seasons. The Domain was the first vineyard in the village to embrace organic agriculture. The use of traditional and natural vinification methods shows the constant quest for high-quality wine and environmentally aware wine cultivation. The wines produced by the Domain are organically grown and the grapes are cultivated with biodynamic methods following the Demeter International Standards.

### The Terroir

Situated on a hillside, benefitting from a pebble land, a Mediterranean climate and an exposition to southern winds, the harvest is naturally healthy and confers upon the wine the typical characteristics of the local soil. The composition of the soil for the cuvee Béret Bleu is Galets roulés (rounded glacial rocks, predominantly quartzite) on mainly white clay and sand over a clay subsoil.
