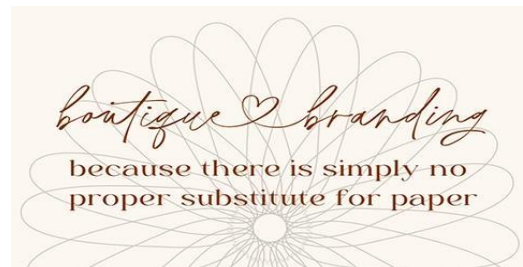

General Information

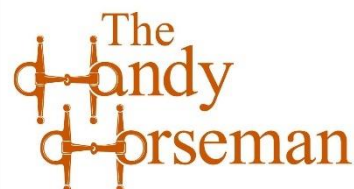
1. The Horse Show Management, nor Blue Valley Riding Center, LLC will not be responsible for any damages, injury, or loss of persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
2. ASTM approved helmets must be worn at all times while mounted.
3. Dogs must be leashed at all times.
4. Current negative coggins required.
5. A processing fee of \$40 will be made for all non-negotiable checks. It will be expected that any returned checks will be 'made good' within 10 days from notice.
6. All fence heights are approximate.
7. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change specifications as competition warrants. Show Management reserves the right to adjust the format of the class (es) to Hunt n Go if needed due to time constraints.
8. **Horses may be ridden in more than one derby by different riders, but may not be ridden by more than one rider in the same derby. Horse/Rider combo may only enter ONE derby. EXCEPTION: Cross entry is allowed for the 2'3 Derby & 2'6 Hunt and Go Derby until quota met.**
9. Hacking is permitted in the ring until 7:30 AM, absolutely NO JUMPING (except for over designated schooling jumps) will be permitted except while on course in a class. Cross rail entries will be allowed to school cross rails from 7:30-7:45. The ring will be open for handwalking only between derbies for 10 minutes.
10. Each warm-up will be judged and awarded ribbons 1st-6th. Each derby will be judged and awarded ribbons and prizes 1st-10th. NO WARM UP FOR CROSSRAIL DERBY or HUNT AND GO. Warm-Up will be a MAXIMUM of 6 jumps. Management reserves the right to shorten course to appropriate length or cancel warm-up altogether if time doesn't allow. **Warm up is restricted to only horse/rider combinations entered in the following derby.**
11. Classic derbies will have a two-round format, a Classic Hunter Round and a Handy Hunter Round, with the top 10 scores from the first round returning. Each will receive a numerical score, and be judged on soundness, hunter pace, performance, jumping style and brilliance. High option(s) will be available to add one additional point per high option taken. Scores will be added together to determine the final placings of each derby.
12. Hunt and Go will have a traditional format, a Classic Hunter round with 5-7 jumps and a Handy Round with 5-7 jumps. The classic round shall be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. After the completion of the classic round, horses will pick up their pace and continue immediately on to the handy portion. Riders are not permitted to walk or pause between rounds. A score will be given for each round, including bonus point (s) for any high options taken and totaled together to determine 1st-10th Place.
13. The decision of the judge and/or steward will be final.
14. Entries, counts, results, and all information will be on horseshowing.com
15. **Pre-entries close October 15, 2024 at 9 pm. All Derby classes will have a posted order of go. Entries received past closing time will incur a \$20 post entry fee & will go to top of posted order.** MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CLOSE ENTRIES EARLY IF MAXIMUM CAPACITY IS REACHED. ENTER EARLY!
16. Jumps will resemble obstacles found in the hunt field, such as coops, rolltop, brush, logs, etcetera. Riders in the 2' and up derbies may be asked to exit the ring while on course; course will be kept relevant to skill level.

Derby Specifications

Judged Warm-Up Entry fee: \$30: Shown over a shortened course with a maximum of six jumps. To be awarded ribbons 1st-6th. CROSSRAIL and HUNT AND GO DO **NOT** HAVE A WARM-UP.

Cross entry is only allowed between 2'3 Derby & 2'6 Hunt and Go. NO OTHER CROSS ENTRY ALLOWED. Warm up is restricted to only horse/rider combinations entered in the following derby. Formal attire optional. Braiding optional. 2 round classic & handy format and Hunt and Go, additional points awarded for high option(s). Top 10 will return for 2nd handy round in classic derbies. Ribbons awarded 1st-10th. Riders asked to ride for ribbons & photos.

Crossrail Derby: Entry Fee \$65 Sponsored by Veltri. 18" cross-rails with 2' option (s). Open to JR & AMATEUR riders who have not shown above 2' before at any horse show. Trotting in corners not penalized. Will not be asked to leave the ring.

\$250 2' Open Hunter Derby: Entry Fee \$75 Sponsored by JBS Immaculate Auto. 2' course with 2'3 option (s). May be asked to leave the ring at walk only. Trotting in corners not penalized.

Payout: 1st: \$100 2nd: \$65 3rd: \$45 4th: \$20 5th: \$15 6th: \$5

\$750 2'3 Open Hunter Derby: Entry Fee \$100 Sponsored by Four Branch Farm & Hoofbooks. 2'3 course with 2'6 option (s). May be asked to leave the ring at walk or trot. May cross enter into 2'6 Hunt and Go.

Payout: 1st: \$225 2nd: \$165 3rd: \$130 4th: \$95 5th: \$55 6th: \$40 7th: \$20 8th: \$15

\$1250 2'6 Open Hunt and Go Derby: Entry Fee \$150 Sponsored by Butewicz Lifestyle Real Estate. 2'6 course with 2'9 option (s). May be asked to leave the ring at walk or trot. Derby will run traditionally, with 5-7 jumps in the initial classic round, immediately followed by 5-7 jumps in the handy round (no walk or break in-between rounds). May cross enter into 2'3 Derby.
