## From our Founder

Yung Prodigy is a uniquely positioned community organisation dedicated to the forgotten victims of crime, by the forgotten victims of crime. Founded in January 2023, we began with a truth and a vision: to liberate young people from the impacts of the carceral system and parental incarceration across the continent. We did not start with resources or as an initiative ignited by a trending political topic. We began from the harsh reality that tens of thousands of children and young people experience the trauma of parental incarceration and are invisible to the wider community and service system.

No one else in this country does this work the way we do. Yung Prodigy is truly youth-led and willing to be innovative and speak the truth. While we may not have ongoing support from traditional funding bodies, this independence is one of our strengths. It allows us to remain authentic, focused on our mission and unbound by external standards that don't align with our purpose or best practice. However, this independence also means that securing resources as an independent entity presents its challenges.

With an upcoming international conference focused on children and young people impacted by parental incarceration, it is vital that we not only attend and present, but that we also break barriers of accessibility. This is more than a sponsorship package; this is an opportunity to support and amplify lived experience and youth-led solutions on a global stage. This is building a movement.

#### **About Yung Prodigy**

Yung Prodigy is a youth-led and youth-run organisation founded on lived experience. We focus on mobilising young people impacted by parental and kinship incarceration, addressing an often-invisible issue and policy gap in Australian service provision. This gap impacts an estimated 40,000+ young people. Our vision is to liberate young people from the impacts of the carceral system, equipping them with the skills, resources, and community support needed to dismantle cycles of systemic disadvantage. Yung Prodigy operates through five key avenues, being; research, advocacy, education, mentorship, and nourishment.
