Vallejo 4th of July Parade Rules

Parade Participants

Thank you so much for supporting our 171st Vallejo Parade. Here are a few rules you need to review and follow:

1. HAVE FUN!
2. Parade participants may distribute flyers. Do not throw anything into the crowd. Children along the route will run out into the street and we do not want any accidents. Violators may be asked to leave the parade.
3. Children under the age of 4 who are performing must be provided transportation on parade route.
4. Groups of children 13 years and under shall be accompanied by one adult for every 10 children.
5. Each entry MUST maintain a distance of no more than 50 feet from the entry ahead of them.
6. No standing on a moving flatbed truck or float unless individuals are protected by a fixed guard to prevent falling or being thrown from the truck.
7. Parade marshals and officials MUST be obeyed. The committee reserves the right to disqualify any entry, which in their opinion, does not enhance the parade and will be immediately ejected.
8. All entries are allowed no more than a 60 second performance time in the reviewing area.
9. Cash prizes will be mailed. Trophies can be pickup at 425A Virginia St., Vallejo, CA 94590 beginning Wednesday, July 8, 2025.
