

Reproductive Privacy Act Notification

The **Kennewick Public Hospital District, doing business as Two Rivers Health District** (the District) recognizes, as provided in RCW 9.02.100 that every individual possesses a fundamental right of privacy with respect to personal reproductive decisions. The District, however, no longer provides any medical or health care services directly. It contracts **Trios Health** to provide medical and healthcare services for the benefit of the constituents of the District and others. Included in those services are obstetric services.
