

Strength for Your Journey: Persevering with Hope

WEEK 6 — Persevering with Hope

Scripture References:

Romans 5:3–5

Hebrews 10:23

Psalm 31:24

Devotional

Life does not always move according to our plans. Seasons of waiting, disappointment, or unexpected trials can make hope feel distant. Yet hope is not wishful thinking—it is trusting God’s promises even when the outcome is unseen.

Consider **Joseph** in the Old Testament (Genesis 37–50). Betrayed by his brothers, sold into slavery, falsely accused, and imprisoned, Joseph’s journey seemed hopeless. Yet he persevered, holding onto faith in God’s plan. Eventually, God elevated him to a position of influence where he could save nations and fulfill His purposes. Joseph’s story reminds us that even when life feels unfair and long, God is weaving a plan beyond what we can see. Perseverance rooted in hope keeps our hearts steady and our faith alive.

Hope does not remove the obstacles, but it sustains us through them. It gives us courage to take one more step, strength to endure one more day, and confidence that God is at work behind the scenes. When we hold onto hope, we allow God to transform waiting, pain, and struggle into testimony and blessing.

Reflection & Application

Pause and let God renew your hope today:

- Begin with this prayer:

“Lord, help me persevere with hope. Strengthen my faith and keep my heart steady.”

- Identify one situation where hope feels difficult to maintain.
- Reflect on Joseph’s story—how God turned betrayal, hardship, and waiting into purpose. Let that inspire your own perseverance.
- Choose one Scripture from today to carry as a reminder that God’s promises are true.
- When discouragement comes, pause, breathe, and whisper:
“I will trust God’s plan and persevere with hope.”
