POSITION PURPOSE

This position will be responsible for mixing paint and applying paint based on orders scheduled for the shift, inspecting and painting components of various substrates such as metal, plastic and fiberglass along with general maintenance and cleaning of equipment. Both Priming, and a Finish coatings are required to be performed for this position. This job is for a reliable, hard working individual that has a high level of attention to detail with the ability to work independently and efficiently while being focused on safety and continuous improvement.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working in a safe manner and following all safety rules.
- While working with a paint assistant, demonstrate leadership skills through encouragement, on-the-job development and redirection as well as motivation.
- While working with a paint assistant to load and unload paint booths, mix paint to mix ratios provided.
- Applying an "A" Finish single stage and base clear top coats.
- Apply Primer as required.
- Inspect product before and after coatings applied to ensure quality expectations are met.
- Ensure the flow of work orders is maintained as directed by following schedule and proper staging of jobs.
- Complete assigned work within given timeframe and according to specifications.
- Keep all work areas, spray equipment, spray booths including staging area clean and organized.
- Maintain all quality standards in accordance with the specifications for each job in order to meet customer requirements.
