DRESS REHEARSAL FORMAT

First 12 numbers on the schedule (see the lineup attachment) arrive at 5:30 pm

5:45 – 6:45 pm #1-12 on stage *Dancers can leave after their dance is run on stage!

6:45 – 7:45 pm #13-24 (arrive by 6:15 pm)

Please arrive 15 minutes early, just in case we are running early.

***NO parents backstage or in audience** for dress rehearsal – CCC regulations

Performances - Saturday, June 6 AND Sunday, June 7: 2:00 pm

WHERE DO WE GO WHEN WE ARRIVE?

For the **Dress Rehearsal** and **Performance days**, dancers enter through the Stage Door to the left (south side) of the Cultural Centre parking, **NOT the main entry door**. Turn right down the hallway and follow the signs to the Rotary Hall and locate your child's class. There will be volunteers to show you where to go.

WHAT TIME DO WE ARRIVE FOR THE SHOWS?

Recreation Shows Sat., June 6 & Sun., June 7:

1st half dancers (numbers 1-12) arrive in costume & makeup by 1:30 pm

2nd half dancers (numbers 13-24) arrive in costume & makeup by 2:30 pm

WHO IS PERMITTED IN THE HOLDING AREAS WITH MY CHILD?

For young children, 1 person per child is permitted backstage at the Dress Rehearsal only. There will be assigned parent and student volunteers helping at the shows. Due to volume of students and fire codes, we need to limit the number of people backstage.

HOW DO WE ARRIVE?

Have your child in **costume, hair and makeup**, and in the case of those with costume changes, in her/his first costume on the lineup. Please have dancers wear something over their costume to protect it, and to keep it a surprise for the audience!

If you have a quick costume change, please let staff know ahead of time at the venue.

DO I HAVE TO BUY TICKETS TO THE SHOW?

YES – if you are a spectator in the audience. **Every person that watches the show from the audience needs a ticket!** (let the venue know if you are bringing a baby – they require a ticket, although free). *No baby buckets allowed in the theatre (CCC regs).

If your child who is a dancer plans to watch either the 1st or 2nd half of the show, they will require a ticket to watch from the theatre!

Please limit your ticket purchase to 4 tickets per dancer to help ensure that all parents get to see their child perform. Any extras will be released after that time.

Please do not buy tickets for both the Saturday and Sunday Rec shows – they are exactly the same shows, and this will help to ensure that all students can have someone in the audience!

*Tickets are not required if you are just dropping off in the holding areas.

SHOW APPROX. 2 1/4 hours from start to finish. This show has an intermission.

Tickets will be on sale through the Chilliwack Cultural Centre only, online or in person.

WHO WILL BE WATCHING MY CHILD BACKSTAGE?

Parent Volunteers have been assigned for the holding areas. These parents will be in charge of the classes, taking attendance, monitoring needs and behaviour. The exit doors will be monitored.

The student helpers are responsible for bringing the dancers from the Rotary Hall to and from backstage, taking children to and from the bathroom, keeping order in lineups backstage and ensuring that all costumes, hair accessories etc. are matching. These student helpers are experienced dancers and child minders – please give them your respect.

You may drop off your child for the Dress Rehearsal and performances – they will be looked after for the duration of the show!

WHAT SHOULD I BRING FOR MY CHILD BACKSTAGE?

We highly recommend you have your child bring water, non-messy (**NUT-FREE***) snacks, colouring, electronic games/video or anything to keep children busy during the waiting times in between.

IS YOUR CHILD IN TAP?

The Chilliwack Cultural Centre requires any dancer with tap shoes to please **cover them with socks in all areas other than the stage.**

ABSOLUTELY NO Flash Photography (distracting and dangerous)

CAN I BUY FLOWERS FOR MY DANCER?

Small bouquets for \$15 will be available for purchase at the CCC, organized by the PD Parent Committee (from Fairfield Flowers) for Mini and Rec shows, until they sell out.

NOTE – you are not allowed to take flowers into the theatre – we will label and keep your flower purchases for you until the show concludes.

***A note about dance theatre etiquette** – the dancers would so appreciate it if you would consider staying for at least half of the show and refrain from getting up and leaving after your child dances. It's so disheartening for the dancers before the end of the halves to dance to an almost empty audience, and distracting to have people coming and going while trying to focus on assembling on stage for the next number.

Also, we are so fortunate to have such a beautiful local venue to dance in. Please be respectful of the Cultural Centre staff and volunteers, as there are specific rules they need to adhere to. Thank you 😊
