Equipment List: Camporee or Troop Campout

Personal Equipment

Sleeping bag or blankets
Foam pad for insulation during cooler weather
***Waterproof Poncho or Raincoat**
Hat: ball cap for summer, stocking cap for cold weather
Extra socks
Uniform (we always travel in uniform!)
Extra clothes and shoes as desired (check the weather!)
***Mess kit (plate and cup at least)**
***Eating utensils (knife, fork, and spoon)**
Toilet articles - especially toothbrush and paste
***Canteen**
Flashlight and extra batteries
Pocketknife
Insect repellent
Plastic garbage bag to cover your pack or duffel bag
Scout Handbook
Money, usually \$5, for your share of the patrol food,
payable at the Monday meeting before
the camping trip
Something in which to carry this gear. A backpack or knapsack
is best. A duffel bag is fine if you don't have to go far on
foot. Just remember to keep it to whatever you can carry
comfortably in a single trip!

*** The important items most often left at home!**

Ax and saw	Rope
First-aid kit	Compass
Patrol flag	Paper towels

Tents, tarps, pegs, and poles	Dining fly, poles, and pegs
